 In the name of God Amen, the ninth day
 of September 1773, I Thomas Horn of the
 province of ~~North Carolina~~ County of ~~Wilmington~~
 being very Sick and weak in Body but of
 perfect mind and memory thanks be given
 unto God, therefore calling unto mind
 the mortality of my body and knowing
 that it is appointed for all men once to die
 do make and ordain this my last will and
 Testament as follows. —
 Principally and first of all I give and
 recommend my soul into the hand of God,
 that give it and my body I recommend to the
 earth to be buried in a decent Christian
 burial at the discretion of my Executor
 nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection
 I shall receive the same again by the mighty
 Power of God and as touching such —
 worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God
 to bless me with in this life, I give I sell
 and dispose of the same in the following
 manner and form, First I give and bequeath
 unto my Son James Horn the sum of ten
 Shillings of proclamation Money. Also I
 give and bequeath unto my Son William
 Horn the sum of ten Shillings proclamation
 Money. Also I give and bequeath unto my
 Son Joseph Horn the sum of ten
 Shillings proclamation Money. Also I give
 and bequeath unto my Daughter Sabitha
 Jearcaster the sum of three pounds proclamation
 Money. Also to my dearly beloved Wife
 Mary Horn I give & bequeath the land
 whereon I now live also part of a tract whereon

 following. First I do leave to my wife

 and a Negro boy name Dred till he death
 or marriage then I do give and bequeath to
 my son John Johnson the above mentioned
 Negro Dred. at my life Death or marriage
 then I do give unto my son James Johnson
 the above mentioned Negro Pat. at my life
 death or marriage

then I do give and bequeath to my son William Johnson
 a Negro Women name Sarah and her increase
 from this date then I do give and bequeath
 to my Daughter Ann Clark five pound
 then I do leave to my wife Sarah Johnson her
 Choice feather bed and rug and blanket and
 two pair sheets and the other furniture
 belonging to it and two Pows and Pulley and two
 Haffing and two Shaws and three such as she
 makes choice of with two sows & piggs eight
 head of two year old Hage my young
