Item I will my just debts to be paid before my estate  
is distributed

Item I leave to my wife Susanna Parker the  
plantation wheron I now live with all my  
said servants belonging with profits of \$2.  
Some during her natural and after her decease  
I give and bequeath it the plantation wheron  
I now live with the land the Blue Branch called  
Blue water to my son Issac Parker his heirs  
and assigns forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son Samuel  
Parker all my land on the east side of  
the S. Blue water Branch to him & his heirs  
forever

Item I leave my negro minnion to my wife Susanna  
Parker during her natural life and after  
decease to fall and belong to my son Isack  
Parker and in case he dies without heirs  
to descend and belong between my two children  
to wit Samuel Parker & Susanna Parker  
to them and their heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son John the  
Parker twenty shillings sterling

Item I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Parker

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Simond  
One cow and calf to her & her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son John Parker  
One cow and calf to him & his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Charity Chestnut  
One fether bed & furniture to her & her heirs forever

Item I leave to my wife Susanna Parker all the rest  
of my estate which I have not yet bequeath  
during her natural and after decease to be equally  
divided between my four children to wit my  
Parker of Susanna Parker to her Parker &  
Nancy Parker to them & their heirs forever

Item I constitute and appoint my wife Susanna  
Parker & my son Isaac Parker Executrix of  
this my last will & testament. Ratifying &  
Confirming the same under my hand & seal this  
11 day of February 1778

Acres be the same more or less & also after  
there is money raised out of my estate to pay my  
just debts then the remainder part of my  
Estate I do also lind to my wife as above said  
Item I give and devise to my son Robert Norton  
after the decease of his widow of his mother  
the land & plantation as above mentioned  
to him and his heirs forever lawful begatton  
of his own body but if he shoud die with  
out an heir of his own then the former  
land and premises to be sold the money  
to be equally divided amongst all the rest  
of children to wit William Norton Francis  
Norton John Norton Margaret Norton Ann  
Norton Sarah Norton & Hannah Norton  
& lastly I do devise & ordaine that the remainder  
part of my Estate after the death or widow  
hood of my wife to be equally divided among  
all my children above named

Item I devise William Jason & Prudent Measur  
Executors of these my last will & testament  
the 18<sup>th</sup> day of July 1778

with money negro manke ladd and six head of cattle  
and six head of sheep and one mare one foal and one
