discretion of my executors hereafter named and
as to such worldly estate as it hath pleased almighty

Item first of all my will and desire is that all my
debts and funeral charges shall be paid and
discharged

Then I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca
Twenty shillings unexpired or my also
Sarah Mitchell or her heirs

Virginia money and all the rest of my Estate
I leave to be sold at public sale and the money
arising to be equally amongst the rest of my
children as they come of age to wit Anne Stuart
Jemima Stuart James Stuart Thomas Stuart
& Letha Stuart

Now I do hereby testify and appoint Mr. Nathan
Williams & William Stuart my full and whole
and sole Executors of this my last will and
testament
