In the name of God Amen I Joseph Taylor of Northampton County
and State of North Carolina being at present very sick
& weak of body but in perfect sound mind and memory
thankful to God hereinafter setting to mind the mortality
of my body do make & ordain this my last will & Testament
in manner & form as follows witnesseth

Item, I give to my Grand Son Joseph Taylor five Shillings

Item, I give to my son Joseph Taylor his house & plantation
wherein I live during his life & at his death I give the
same to my grand Son Dennis to him to his posterity.

Item, I give to my daughter Peggy Allen my feather Bed & furniture

Item, I give to my daughter Mary Taylor one feather bed of a value

Item, I give to my Son John Taylor five Shillings -

Item, I give to my grand Son Dennis Taylor the bed & furniture
wherein I lie,

Item, I give to my wife Mary Taylor all the residue & remain
der of my estate without debt & without claim to her
her heirs & friends

I do nominate & appoint my Son Joseph Taylor my
whole Estate of this my last will & Testament
including everything all other odds & ends to his mortadly
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand

In the name of God Amen I Joseph Schuman of Northampton
County & Province of North Carolina being & in my last will & Testament
in my perfect sound mind & memory do make this my last
will & Testament forthwith. I give my Soul to God that gave
it me & my body to the dust from whence it came & as
for my earthly goods after my Death is decently buried
and my just debts paid I shall despatch as follows witnesseth
Item I give & bequeath to my Son Joseph Schuman half my
personal Estate of this my decease,

Item I give unto my daughter Lucy Robinson an One & Calf
and the other part of my Estate my wife & children is that it
should be equally divided amongst all my children likewise
to appoint Joseph Schuman & Jacob Beck my whole Estate
between them & I do hereby disannul all other Wills from the date
hence whence I have fixed my Seal & signed my name
