In the name of god Amen this twentieth day of
March One thousand seven hundred and Eighty four
I Isaac Lapsiter of Hampton County State
of North Carolina being sick in body but of good
and sound memory Thanks be to god for the same
and calling to mind the uncertain Estate of this
transitory life and that all flesh must
yield to death when it shall be pleased god
to call do make constitute Ordain and declare
this to be my last will & testament in manner
and form following reciting disarming
by these presents all and Every Other testament
Or Testaments Will or Wills by me heretofore
made by me and declare this to be my last
will & testament and as Other and just being
sorry for my past sins most humbly desire
forgiveness for the same and now for the settling
of my temporal Estate and such gods chattels
and debts as it hath pleased god to bestow upon me
I do order and give and dispose the same in
manner and form following that is to say first
that all such debts and dues be paid within convenient
time after my decease by my Executors hereof named

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Isabella Rogers
the wife of Abraham Rogers five shillings
to her & her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucrecia
Belanchard five shillings to her & her heirs forever

Item I give unto my son James Lapsiter five shillings
to him & his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Isaac Lapsiter
all my land on the north East side of the neck
Barnes containing One hundred and ten Acres
to him and his heirs and assigns forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Jacob Lapsiter

that tract of land I had of Edwin Bridges
containing Eighty Eight Acres of Land to him
and his wife and affixes former Also Managers girl
called Bridges to him and his heirs or affixes forever

I give and bequeath to unto my son Melvin Lapides
one negro girl named Gile to him & his
Heirs and assigns forever.

Then I give Rhymath unto my son Aaron Sapia, my
maxim plantation stands on the west side of the
rock branch containing one hundred and threescore
to him his heirs & assigns forever.

I lend to my beloved wife Mary Lapeth my negro
wrench Big & my negro wench Rachel & my negro
wench Sam & my negro girl Phillis & my negro
girl Ann & the rest of Estate that is not afore
mentioned to her during her life & after her decease

I give & bequeath unto my six daughters Martha Lap-
 ter, Mary Lapiter, Fanny Lapiter, Ann Lapiter, Mi-
 chael Lapiter, Minnie Lapiter, all my Estate that I
 lent to my wife to be equally divided amongst the
 said six daughters to them their heirs & assigns for
 ever & I do nominate & appoint my friend J. P.
 Williams & my friend James Clemon my sole
 Executors of this my last will & Testament & do
 publish, pronounce this to be my last will &

Newington County in the State of North Carolina being
sick weak of body but of sound Memory
thinks he to god for the same & desiring to remove
the uncertainty of this transitory life that I must
yield to death when it shall please God to call
I do make this my last will & Testament in manner
& form as followeth that is to say, I Commit my Soul to
God that gave it hoping to receive the same at the
Great day of Judgment, with full pardon of my
sins through the merit of my Saviour Jesus Christ
our Lord & my body to be buried by my Executors
after mentioned first of all my debts to be
paid & I do give & devise as follows.

Then I lend unto my beloved Alike Sarah Rogers & my daughter
in Law Elizabeth Brown my plantation and all
my land during their life also I lend the use of
all my negroes Rose Lucy Bridget Phillis & Anne
& all my estate in doors & out to my beloved Alike
Sarah Rogers during her life And after her decease

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I give by way of anty my son in Law Henry Throdd
my plantation & Tract of Land Containing three Hun-
dred & thirty Acres to him & his heirs forever.

Then I give the mark unto my daughter Ann Johnson
One Negro named Rose also our negro named Ph
is to her & her his forever.

Given this my Daughter Sarah Thorneau
Negro named Bridget also son negro named Peter
to her this time forever

From I gave Shigwath into my Daughter in Law's
Barn and Chas Hales & his Carriage of Corn of four hundred
Wright of Pork to her other skins for over - also two sets
Spring to her other skins for over.
