 & all the rest of my Estate I leave to be Equally Divided between
 my Mother Brothers & Sisters except John Tyner & Wm Tyner
 I do hereby Constitute & Appoint my Brother Nicholas Tyner & William
 Sherwood full & whole sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testa
 ment I do hereby make Bevan & Baird another Will &
 testamant by me heretofore made & acknowledge this to be my
 last In witness whereunto I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 this 23rd of December in the Year of our Lord 1781.

In the Name of God Amen I Siddleberry Long of the County of Northampton
 in the State of North Carolina being of Perfect Mind & Memory thank
 Almighty God for the same But Calling to mind the Mortality that
 attends every body doth appointe for all men to say &
 make a Constitution this to be my last will & Testament in manner
 from following first of all I commend my soul into the hands
 of Almighty God that giveth hope through the death
 minds & purposes of my Saviour Jesus Christ Whom full &

from this & thence of my Soul to my body to commit to
 the Earth to be buried decent Christian like manner at the Dis
 cretion of my executors Hereafter named Next to such worldly
 Estate as it hath pleased God almighty to bestow upon me give
 my Heirath in manner of form following
 Item first of all my wife & Belie is that all my debts & funeral
 charges shall be paid & discharged.
 Item I give my Heirath unto my beloved wife Anne Long my Hidng Horse
 Item I give unto my son John Long that Due of Land lying the new branch
 of Tyner line containing four hundred & Sixty acres bearing date
 of february the 18th 1754. I also give unto my son John Long
 two negroes Nick Bluke two Cows & Calves one horse to keep at
 the age of twenty one years
 Item I give unto my son Frederick Long all the remainder part of my
 Lands every other also two negroes named Chang & Jacob
 also Two Cows & also also one horse to keep at the age of twenty
 one years.
 Item I give unto my Daughter Mary Long two negroes named Rose
 Sarah also two Cows & Cales to keep at the age of eighteen years
 or marriage.
 Item I give unto my wife Anne Long three negroes named Kader
 Jenny & York during her natural life or widowhood also the use
 of the Children negroes while they come of age of my wife
 Shantia & Mary, and if she should marry
 Item my executors to take them their out for the use of my Children
 I also gave the three negroes that I left to my wife Kader Jenny
 York, to be Equally Divided between my two Sons John Long &
 Frederick Long & daughter Mary Long at the decease of my wife.
 I give unto my Son John Long & Frederick Long & my Daughter
 Mary Long each of them a feather bed of furniture I also give unto my
 wife one feather bed of furniture, I also leave unto my wife
 the use of all the remainder part of my Estate during her natural
 life or widowhood if my wife Shantia marries or dies then to
 be Equally Divided between my three Children John Long
 Frederick Long & Mary Long.

Item I do hereby constitute & appoint my friends Jeptha Williams
Samuel Lee & Thomas Fingers & John Thorowood full
whole estate executors of this my last will & Testament.

Item I do hereby make & appoint & constitute other wills & testaments
by me heretofore made & acknowledge to be my last will
in so far as whereof I have herunto set my hand & seal

Sarah shantors marry my wife & desire it that herfaut said
Negroes fall to me a yoh Brown to him thishins forever.
And my further will & desire I do appoint Jeptha Brittle my
whole estate executors of this my last will & Testament.
and witness hereunto set my hand & seal this 18 of
February 1781

Robert Pele Will

I Robert Pele of a W.D. Thamptow family in this state
hereinafter being aged & infirm of body although believed
to be the all wise disposer of all things of sound & undi-
sposing mind & memory & calling to say mind that is
appointed to now oule to die do make & ordain this
my last will & Testament in manner & form
following namely -

Firstly I give & bequeath unto each of my fine clarsy chil-
dren, viz, Robert & Isaac Pele, Elizabeth Bryant, Mary
Hallowell & Sarah Newson whethen they are already poss-
essed of out of my estate to each of them their hys said
apiges of them.

Item It is my will & desire that all my Negroes, to wit: James,
David & Caesar, Dinah & her young child new boy, Sister Nelly
Sime, Fresses & all the increase of the sd Dinah & her four
children if any. They shall have their freedom if in the
Laws of the Land should a dist of them having that privi-
lege freely, clearly & absolutely until which time it is
my will & desire I do hereby give & bequeath unto my
fine children above named my two negroes James and
David & that the profit arising from their labor be equally
divided. Item provided they dont sell her or remove her
remote from their wives or contrary to their choice -

Item I give and bequeath unto my son David Pele & my two nie-
ces Lord Cornelius Bell and my daughter Judith,
Rachel & Celie my six Negroes Caesar & Sister Dinah,
Nelly Sime, Fresses and their increase if any to be equal-
ly divided according to values unto them their hys, apiges
until the days above a dist of their freedom -

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Newson one
bed & furniture to her & his forever -

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter a black jennet my
horse, & my riding saddle to her & at her disposal -

Item I give & bequeath unto my two daughters Rachel & Celie
