with all the remainder of my Estate not heretofore given away  
be sold & the money arising therefrom whatsoever I have  
after paying two hundred & twenty pounds Rock, to my first  
Daughters Rebecca, Sarah, Sabitha Cuttron & Anna, being  
their part of 40 to be equally divided between my Sons.

James, John, Benjamin, Martin, William Rock & Grand  
son Robert Rock & I do <sup>appoint</sup> my two Sons John &  
Benjamin Rock, executors of this my last Will & Testament  
Respecting all other wife heretofore by me made. In ait  
exp whereof I have hereto set my hand & seal the day  
of year first aforesw. John Rock his <sup>mark</sup> & seal  
Signed, sealed & published in the presence of

Northampton County December 1<sup>st</sup> 1783.

### Thomas Sawyer Will

In the name of God Amen. Thomas Sawyer of Northampton County  
State of N. Carolina being sick & weak & calling to mind  
the certainty of death the uncertainty therof do make &  
relinquish my last Will in manner following.

- 1<sup>st</sup> It is my will & desire that all my just debts be discharged at the execution  
time of my executors after manner
- 2<sup>nd</sup> I give & bequeath unto my daughter Francis Heath one negro girl named  
Doll to her heirs forever
- 3<sup>rd</sup> I give & bequeath unto my grandson Samford Sawyer one negro  
boy boy named Abram to him & his heirs forever.
- 4<sup>th</sup> It is my will & desire that all my negroes that I have not  
given away be kept together to maintain my family

until my Son Thomas Sawyer comes of age & then to be equally divided  
by an order of Court amongst my following Children, Sarah Sawyer,  
Henry Sawyer, Thomas Sawyer & William Sawyer to have & share alike,  
to them their heirs forever.

- 5<sup>th</sup> I likewise give my son Henry Sawyer one bed & furniture to him &  
his heirs forever
- 6<sup>th</sup> I likewise give my daughter Sarah Sawyer one bed & furniture  
to her heirs forever
- 7<sup>th</sup> I likewise give & bequeath to my son Thomas Sawyer one Bed & furniture  
to him this heirs forever
- 8<sup>th</sup> I likewise give & bequeath to my son Wm Sawyer one bed & furniture  
to him his heirs forever
- 9<sup>th</sup> It is likewise my will & desire that if my just debts can not be  
paid without Selling my Stock, that my Stock shant be sold  
& all my household Furniture that I have not given away by  
will, & after my just debts being paid, If any overplus  
shant be remaining, my desire that it shant be equally  
divided amongst all my fore mentioned Children to them  
their heirs forever.
- 10<sup>th</sup> I give & bequeath unto my son Henry Sawyer One hundred & fifty  
Acre of Land on the North side of what is now known as the  
Swamp, & being the land I purchased of Charles Geddes to him this heirs  
forever.
- 11<sup>th</sup> I give & bequeath unto my son John Sawyer Seven acres of Land  
joining his line, scott line & Williamson's line, being part of a tract  
of Land that I have taken up, on the river Grant to him this heirs  
forever.
- 12<sup>th</sup> I then give & bequeath unto my son Thomas Sawyer One hundred & fifty  
Acres of Land being part of a tract of Land I bought of Matthew  
Eason Beginning at an old pine in the head of a marsh just above  
the river, then running an East Course to the Pocson line of the said  
Land, then along the Pocson line a north course to the corner of  
said line, then a west course along the old pine to another mill  
Swamp then down the river swamp to the first station to him  
this heirs forever.

13 Item I give my mate unto my son Thomas Lawe forty acres of Land begining at the sun Corner Pine of Thomas Lawe, & running his line to the Posthouse then down the left Branch to the swamp, then up the swamp to the first Station, to him this his forever.

14 Item I give my mate unto my son Wm Lawe Ninety three acres Land begining at Ruggins Corner then a long Ruggins line to Potts Corner then a long Potts line to the swamp - Then up the swamp to the first Station, to him this his forever.

15<sup>th</sup> Item and my desire is that my wife & children may be kept for the use of my family until my son Thomas Lawe come of age, then the said wife & children I give unto Thomas Lawe & William Lawe in equal Right to them. Their his forever & my desire is that they shant grind tolls for their Brothers & Sisters.

Sixtly I appoint my son John Lawe & my son Thomas Lawe executors of this my last will & Testament utterly Disannulling & Revoking all other wills <sup>made</sup> before by me made, But this only this to be my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 1<sup>st</sup> day of September 1783.

Mary Cotton Will

Mary Cotton of Northampton County in North Carolina being sick & weak of Body, But thanks be to Almighty God of sound & disposing mind & memory, & calling to mind the uncertainty of all Temporal things, do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner of form following.

In witness I give my mate unto my son Wm Cotton alias Sart on my man the same that has been his to me called his son Colt also a young man called the Old man fifty four years old, his law & pugs

Item I give my mate unto my son James Cotton alias Sart one black mare the same that has before hath been called his son Colt

four years & calves six years & pugs & one feather bed of furniture to him his heirs & assigns forever.

six hours & Proctor feather bed of furniture to him his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give my mate unto my son Allen Cotton one Roan mare the same that has been called his son Harry pangs Specie Hating Spanish & mill Dallas at six Shillings each taken his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give my mate unto my daughter Mary Cotton for her use Specie Hating Spanish & mill Dallas at six Shillings each to him his heirs & assigns for ever.

Item I give my mate, all the sugar that shall fall to my lot in the division of the Estate of my deceased Husband John Cotton, to my three first mentioned Children to wit, William, James and Henry to be equally divided among them according to age, to them their heirs & assigns forever. But it is my will & desire that my Beloved Mother Priscilla Wills have reasonable maintenance out of the profits arising from the labor of the said sugar & further & in my will & desire that shee either or any of my three before mentioned Children die under age or unmarried that then the whole of her other parts or parts of my Estate be equally divided among all my surviving Children mentioned in this my last will & Testament.

Item I give my mate all the remaining part of my Estate not herein before given away to my three first mentioned Children Jonathan Cotton & John Cotton & my daughter Mary Cotton to be equally divided among them and in case either or any of them should die under age or unmarried that then his or her part or parts be equally divided among the survivors to them their heirs & assigns forever.

Sixty I hereby constitute & appoint my trusty friends Thaddeus Cutt and Allen Cotton aforesaid executors of this my last will & testament hereby revoking all wills by me heretofore made
