I William Pace of the County of Northampton in the province  
of North Carolina being in good health and of sound & dis-  
posing mind and memory do make and ordain this my last  
will & Testament in manner following. By express  
I bequeath my soul to God that give it trusting in his  
mercy for remission of all my offences  
and my body to the earth to be decently interred at the dis-  
cretion of my executor herein after appointed & and as  
such world estate as it hath pleased God to bestow on me  
I give and dispose thereof as follows (viz) I give &  
bequeath unto my living wife Elizabeth to her heirs & assigns my  
negro boy called Little John the negro boy named Tom & his friends but

Item I give & bequeath to my loving wife Eliza during the  
term of her natural life and no longer the use of my  
Plantation wheran I now live and the two parcels of  
land therin belonging in the whole about two hundred and  
fifty acres & my negro man called Great Jack my nego  
woman named Sibbit my negro girl named Phubba three  
of my best feather beds one like two Table all my pictures  
& iron alcove belonging to the house and plantation all  
my chest chairs & stock of Cale & Hogs Housis mens shirts  
all checkered gies & divers to my dear wife during her natural  
life and no longer but with this except power author-  
ity to give & dispose of such part of the land Cattle hopy her  
so as she shall think proper unto my son or any of them  
such apportionment or gift to be good and valid.

I give and devise to my son Polomen Pace his heirs and  
spwigns forever two hundred & aers of land which I pur-  
chase of Barnaby Stokemey one situate on the head of  
urahaw Swamp and joining the lands of William  
Howell one negro man named Tom also one negro  
boy named Major and one bird of paradise

Item I give and bequeath unto my son William Pace & his  
heirs and spwigns forever two negro slaves named  
Sarah & woman and pony apollow

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Abigail Weston  
and to her heirs and spwigns forever one negro girl  
called Elizabeth also ten pounds proclamation money

Item I give and bequeath to my son Stephen Pace & his  
heirs & spwigns forever my negro boy named Tom my  
negro girl named Phubba & one feather bed & furniture

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Dr. wife Pace her  
heirs and spwigns forever my negro girl named Pat

Item I give and bequeath to my son Harry Pace his heirs  
& spwigns forever from and immediately after the  
death of my wife, the plantation wherein I now  
reside with the two parcels of land therin

beloring containing in the whole about two hundred and fifty acres of my water front miles and land thento begining forty acres more or less.

Item I give and bequeath unto my said Son Harry Pace his heirs and assigns my negro girl named Drank also one negro girl named Pink my duck and one round table & one feather bed of furniture.

Item I give and bequeath to my said Son Harry Pace his heirs & assigns from & immediately after the decease of my wife Celia the slave negro slave a her in before bequeath to her during the term of her natural life to wit year last hold & helpe

Item I give and bequeath to my wife Celia during the term of her natural life and no longer all the rest and residue of my estate of what nature or quality so ever after paying all my just debts and funeral expenses.

Item I give and divide to my four Sons to aft, Solomon, William Stephen and Hardy & to their assigns from and immediately after the decease of my said wife Celia all the personal Estate which I have bequeath to her during the term of her natural life which is not already by this my last will already otherwise during dispense of equally among such of them as shall be then living to be divided share and share alike.

Lastly I do hereby constitute ordain and appoint my said wife Celia to be whole and sole executrix of this my last will & Testament whereby now being disannulling & rendering void all former wills by me made pronouncing that no other to be my will & Testament. In Testament aforesaid I have hirudis at my hand & seal the Day and year first above written signed seal & published delivered and pronounced by the said William Pace to be his last will & Testament in presence of

Item I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Nancy Hill four Negroes hereafter mentioned Nabby, Allen, Jiles & 2 Cows & also one feather bed of furniture To her & her Heires for ever

Item I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Jean Hill five Shillings to her & her Heires for ever.

Item I give & Bequeath unto Martha Warden five Shillings to her & her Heires for ever.
