Brittain Brittle Will

In the name of God amen I Brittain Brittle of the County of Northampton in the State of North Carolina knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make this my last will & Testament as follows.

Item I give & bequeath unto my wife Sarah one mare & Colt harness one bridle blade to one bed of furniture & if in case my wife Sarah should marry my will & desire is that this four said Negroes fall to one Joseph Brown to him & his heirs forever.

And my further will & desire I do appoint Jeph Brittle my whole sole Executors of this my last will & Testament in all things whereof I have heretofore set my hand & seal this 18th of February, 1781

Robert Pile's Will -

I Robert Pile of Northampton County in the State of North Carolina being aged & infirm of body although blessed be the all wise dispenser of all things of sound mind & disposing mind & memory & calling to my mind that is appointed to me next to die do make & ordain this my last will & Testament in manner & form following namely -

Firstly. I give & bequeath unto each of my fine & dear children, viz, Robert & Isaac Pile, Elizabeth Pile and Mr. of Newmill & Sarah Newson whatever they are already possessed of out of my estate to each of them their heirs and assigns forever -

Secondly. It is my will & desire that all my Negroes, to wit: James, Ben & Cader, Dinah & her four children viz, Sister Molly, Jimmie, Jerses & all the increase of the said Dinah & her four children if any, they shall have their freedom if ever the laws of the said State should admit of their having that privilege freely, clearly & absolutely, until which time it is my will & desire & I do hereby give & bequeath unto my fine children at once named my two Negroes James and Ben & that the profits arising from their labor be equally divided, Thirdly - provided, they don't sell here or remove themselves remote from their wives or contrary to their choice -

Thirdly. I give and bequeath unto my sons David Pile & my son in Law Cornelius Rutland and my Daughters Rachel, Rachael & Celia my six Negroes, Cader, Sister, Dinah, Molly, Jimmie, Jerses and their increase if any to be equally divided according to value unto them their heirs, assigns, until the said State admit of their freedom -

Fourthly. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Newson one Bed & furniture to her & her heirs forever -

Fifthly. I give & bequeath unto my daughter a black Linnch one horse & my riding saddle to her & at her disposal -

Sixthly. I give & bequeath unto my two daughters Rachael & Celia

to each of them one bed & furniture and each of them one chest that have been heretofore called Thins & all my kitchen furniture both of Iron & Pewter & all my silver and cutting board. I give only excepted to be equally divided between to them & their heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son David Pale my daughter Judith Cox & Abba Bennett & my son Isaac Cornish out of all they have in their possession out of my Estate to them their heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my two grand Children Joel Pale & Charity, sons daughter of my son Jeremiah Pale one hundred pounds Virginia Currency in gold & silver Coin to be Equally Divided between them to them & their heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my two Grand Children above named two Cows & Calves two Cows & yearlings Shovel house of Shop to be let out upon Stock in case of my Executors hereafter mentioned to them & their heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my above mentioned grand daughter Charity Pale one feather bed & furniture & one Chest to her & her heirs forever.

Item It is my will & desire that my plantation wherein I now live with all the land thereunto belonging be sold by my Executors hereafter mentioned at their discretion either at publick or private sale the money arising therefrom after all my just debts & Legacies be paid to be Equally divided among my Children I name before mentioned. Judith Cox & Abba Bennett only excepted to them their heirs forever.

Item It is my will & desire that all the remaining part of my Estate not herein before mentioned or given away be Equally Divided among all my Children Abba Bennett only excepted to them their heirs & assigns forever.

lastly I solemnly Constitute & appoint my Trusty & well belovd friends Thomas White Richard Jordan my whole sole Executors of this my last will & Testament hereby revoking making

null & void all other wills by me heretofore made Ratifying & Confirming this only to be my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Eighty two. Robert Pale basical signed sealed & published in the presence of
Benj Jordan, John Williams, Bryan ~~Williams~~ ^{Daughter}, Joseph Jordan, Northampton County & Septer Court 1782.

This will of Robert Pale was proved by the affirmation of Joseph Jordan & Benj Jordan two of the Subscribing Witnesses thereto & Thomas White & Richard Jordan Qualifier & Jurors to the same, & was to be attested & recorded.

Judkins Nicholas Will

I Shewas Nicholas Judkins of Northampton County being aged of Body (so make this writing in manner of my following will & for my last will & Testament (So do it)

Item I give & bequeath to my son James Judkins one Certain plantation Tract or parcel of land Containing by Estimation one hundred acres & being the plantation wherein Caroline & Andrew formerly lived also one feather bed & furniture to him & his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my sons John Judkins & Joel Judkins to be Equally divided between them, one Certain plantation Tract or parcel of land Containing by Estimation three hundred acres which I bought of John Long & Joseph Strickland ^{also} one other to them their heirs & assigns forever. Also I give to my son John one feather bed & furniture & also I give to my son Joel one feather bed & furniture.

Item I give & bequeath to my son Caroline Judkins one Certain plantation tract or parcel of land Containing by Estimation fifty acres & bounded by a part of line of my son from Williams Brown to Caroline Andrews & also the 13th day of May 1782. also one feather bed & furniture to him & his heirs & assigns forever.
