William Brittle Will

In the name of God amen I William Brittle of the County of Northampton in the State of North Carolina knowing that it is apposite for all men once to die to make this my last ulte testament as follows.

Item I give & bequeath unto my wife Sarah one man & half acre on bridge Haddow one bu of far nature & of in case my wife Sarah shoulle marry my wife & desire is that the four said Negroes fall to me & John Brown to have & hold them forever
And my further will & desire I do appoint Jippe Brittle my whole sole executor of this my last ulte testament.
witnesses whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 18 of February 1781

I Robert Peleg of Northampton County in the State of North Carolina being aged & infirm of body although blessed be the all wise disposer of all things of sound mind & disposing mind & memory & calling to my mind that it is appointed to men once to die to make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following namely -

Firstry I give & bequeath unto each of my fine black chil-
dren, viz. Robert & Isaac Peleg, Elizabeth Bryant & Mary
Hollowell & Sarah Newson whatever they are already poss-
essed of out of my estate to each of them their heirs and
assigns forever.

Second It is my will & desire that all my negroes, to wit: James,
Ben & Caesar, Pinah & her four children, my Sister Nelly
Tinne, Teresa & all the increase of the said Pinah & her four
children if any. They shall have their freedom if won the
Laws of the Land should admit of their having that privi-
lege freely, clearly & absolutely until which time it is
my will & desire to do hereby give & bequeath unto my
fine children above named my two negroes James and
Ben, & that the profit arising from their labor be equally
divided. Third - provided they don't sell him or remove them
remote from their wives or contrary to their choice -

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son David Peleg & my two nie-
Land Cornelius Bellard and my Daughter Judith,
Peachael & Celia my six negroes Edes & Foster, Pinah,
Nelly, Tinne, Teresa and their increase if any to be equal-
ly divided according to value unto them their heirs, assigns,
until the days above admitted of their freedom -

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Newson one
bed & furniture to her & hers forever -

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Anna Lurech one
house & my riding saddle to her & at her disposal -

Item I give & bequeath unto my two daughters Rachael & Alice

to each of them one bed & furniture and each of them one
chest that have been heretofore called their to all my
Kitchen furniture both of iron & Pewter & all my Stock
and Cisterns, Ware, Bugs only excepted, to be equally di-
vided between to them & their heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son James Hale & my daughter
Judith Cox & Abba Jennot & my son in law Cornelius Cutters
all they have in their possession out of my Estate to them their
Heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my two grand Children Job Hale &
Charity Son's daughter of my son Jeremiah Hale one hundred
Pounds Virginia Currency in gold & silver Coin to be equal-
ly divided between them & their Heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my two grand Children above named
two Cows & Calves two Caw & yearlings twelve head of sheep
also let out upon stocks in case of my Executors hereafter
mentioned to them & their heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my now mentioned grand daughter
Charity Hale one feather bed of furniture & one Chest to her
their heirs forever.

Item It is my will & desire that my plantation wherein I now
live with all the land therunto bel. belong to her sole by my
executors hereafter mentioned at their discretion either
at publick or private sale the money arising therefrom
after all my just debts & legacies be paid to be equally
divided among my Children I now before mentioned
Judith Cox & Abba Jennot only excepted to them their heirs
forever.

Item It is my will & desire that all the remaining part of my
Estate not herein before mentioned or given away be equal-
ly divided among all my Children Abba Jennot only excepted
to them their heirs & assigns forever.

Lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my trusty & dear beloved friends
Thomas White Richard Jordan my whole executors
of this my last will & Testament Henry Rocking making

well & valid all other will by me hitherto made Ratifying
& Confirming this only to be my last will & testament in
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this twenty
thirst day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred & eighty two. Robert Hale & seal

Item I give & bequeath to my sons John Judkins & Joe Judkins to be
equally divided between them our certain plantation tract
or parcel of land containing by estimation three hundred acres
which I bought of John Long & Joseph Stockland ^{also} our stool to
them their Heirs & assigns forever also I give to my son John
our feather Bed & furniture also I give to my son Joe our feather
Bed & furniture

Item I give & bequeath to my son Cornelius Judkins our certain plantation tract
or parcel of land containing by estimation fifty acres & one hundred
and twelve by a Bush of Corn or more from William Doon to Cornelius
Andrews date the 13th day of May 1782 also our feather bed
& furniture to him his Heirs & assigns forever
