forever 6. I give and bequeath unto my son Peter
Webb One bed and furniture to be his at my death
also One horse Pommel and saddle at the age
of twenty years also my will and desire is
that my son Peter should be Raised and Clothed
Out of my Estate by my son Elisha Webb I give
and bequeath unto my son Elisha Webb all the
rest of my Estate Real and personal after paying
all my Just debts and the before given Legacies to

 Province of North Carolina in perfect health

 tory life and that all flesh must come unto
 dust I do make this and Ordain this to be
 my last will and testament in witness whereof
 following first and principally I give and
 bequeath my soul to god my Creator in whom
 I trust this the merits of my saviour Jesus
 Christ that my soul shall be saved and that
 my soul shall be saved and that my body may
 be buried in Christian Burial and as to

my temporal Estate which it hath pleased god to bestow
 on me I give and bequeath as followeth

Item I give and bequeath as unto my son William Thompson
 the hundred Acres of Land with the plantation
 thereon I have since also I gave my son William
 Thompson one small tract of land his heirs
 and assigns forever Also I think that my son
 may be free at Eighteen years of age and receive
 his Offsets at that age

Item I give to my Daughter Molly Jordan three shillings
 Sterling

Item I give to my Daughter Lucie Hike three shillings
 Sterling I give to my son Daniel Thompson
 One pound

Item I give to my Daughter Anna Thompson One
 Pound I give to my Daughter Mary Thompson
 One Pound I give to my Daughter Letitia Thompson
 one shilling I give to my son Esau Thompson One
 shilling I give to my daughter Lucie Thompson
 the privilege of getting father of the year and
 making her in his

Item I desire that my Children may not be bound
 Out but to live on my plantation above men-
 tioned till my son William Thompson comes to
 age at Eighteen years I bid the rest of my
 personal Estate to the use of my family in a single
 life till my son William Thompson come of age then
 I give the same to my son William Thompson
 his heirs and assigns forever I do hereby nominate
 constitute and appoint William Thompson son of
 and Robert Watson to execute this my last
 Will and testament and I do hereby acknowledge
 this to be my last will and testament Reviving
 all former wills and Acknowledging them to be
 by me therefore made signed sealed and published
