In the name of God Amen, I David Rogers of
Hampden County, in the State of Massachusetts being
in sick weak of body but of sound memory
think me to god for the same & desiring to remove
the uncertainty of this transitory life that I must
yield to death when it shall please God to call
I do make this my last will & Testament in manner
& form as followeth that is to say, I Commit my Soul to
God that gave it hoping to receive the same at the
Great day of Judgment, with full pardon of my
sins through the merit of my Saviour Jesus Christ
our Lord & my body to be buried by my Executors
after mentioned first of all my debts to be
paid & I do give & devise as follows

Then I lend unto my beloved Alike Sarah Rogers & my daughter
in Law Elizabeth Brown my plantation and all
my land during their life also I lend the use of
all my negroes Rose Lucy Bridget Phillis & Anne
& all my estate in doors & out to my beloved Alike
Sarah Rogers during her life And after her decease

Then I give by way of mortgage unto my son in Law Henry Throod
my plantation & Tract of Land containing there Hun-
dred & Sixty Acres to him & his heirs forever.

Then I give the girl unto my daughter Anne Jackson
One Negro named Razi also our negro named Ph
is to his & her his forever.

Given this 24th to my Daughter Sarah Thorne
Negro named Bridget also one negro named Peter
to her this time forever

It was I gave Elizabeth into my Daughter in Law Eliza
Barn two Cows & Hales & ten Barrels of Corn & four hundred
Weight of Pork to her & her Hairs for ever - also two sets
of Rings to her & her Lairs forever.
