- Item I give to my loving wife my negroes to wit Sarah, Bet, and Hannah to her and her heirs forever.
- Item I give likewise to my wife all the rest of my Estate Be it of what nature or kind so ever to her and her heirs forever My will and desire is that if my daughter Angelina Clark Maddie depart this life before she arrives to the age of sixteen years that my nephew Thomas Maddie enjoy her part so decreed and I do nominate and appoint James Clark Hoon Smith & Sham Fennell my Executors of this my last will and testament In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 6<sup>th</sup> Day of December In the year of our Lord 1775

Edah and Ruffin Will

In the Name of God Amen I Edah and Ruffin of Northampton County, in the Province of North Carolina, being weak of Body but of sound and perfect

- mind and memory, thanks be to god for the same, do make and declare this my last will and Testament in manner and form following, first I give and bequeath my soul to god that gave it me and my body to be decently buried, at the discretion of my executor hereafter named and as for my worldly Estate, do order give and dispose of in the following manner
- Item I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Martha Ruffin, one feather bed and consider her choice of them, one cooling cloth, one Linen cloth, all my Pewter, one Small Pine Table, one Small Iron Pot, one frying Pan, Four Cows of Colors, two Sows & Pigs six barrels of Corn, one side Saddle & Bridle one box Iron and hater all my Geese, two geese & Lamb, one small Pine Chest four frames Chairs, also Eleven Pounds ten shillings Poor Money to be raised out of my Estate. Likewise lend her one third part of the Plantation and tract of Land whereon I now live during her natural life the above mentioned Personal Estate to her and her heirs forever.
- Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Ruffin five pounds Virginia Currency to be raised out of my Estate to her and her heirs forever.
- Item I give and bequeath unto my natural son John Ruffin, alias Aquin the Plantation and all the tract of Land whereon I now live, provided he pay unto my executor hereafter named the sum of sixty six Pounds the like shillings and four Pines Poor Money, within one year after my death, for the use and benefit of my son Batholomew Ruffin, and also the sum of sixty six pounds the like shillings four pence Poor Money, within the said term for the use and benefit of my son Edah and Ruffin in order that the same may be put out on Interest

to him and his heirs forever, and in Case he the said John Ruffin, alias Ogden, doth not pay the said sums as above mentioned, or doth die without Issue, my will and desire is that my said plantation and tract of land may be sold to the best advantage by and at the discretion of my Executors, and the money arising therefrom to be equally divided between my said sons Bartholomew and Ethelred Ruffin.

Item My will and desire is, that after all my just debts and legacies are paid all the residue of my Estate both real & personal, be it of what kind or nature soever may be sold to the best advantage, by and at the discretion of my Executors, to be equally divided between my said sons Bartholomew, and Ethelred Ruffin. I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my loving brother Samuel Ruffin, Loving Stephen Ethelred Ruffin & my loving son John Ruffin alias Ogden, my whole and sole Executors to this my last will and testament, revoking, disannulling and making void all former wills and Gifts by me made and declare this only to be my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto sett my Hand & affixed my seal the thirtieth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and seventy three
