mortality of my body, do constitute & ordain this my last
Will & Testament in manner & form following that is to say
first & principally I Commit my soul into the hand of
almighty God, hoping to have full & free pardon of all
my sins to inherit everlasting life, as for my body I
Commit it to the ground from whence it was taken, to be
buried in a Christian & convenient manner at the discre-
tion of my Executors hereafter named, as touching all such
Temporal Estate as it hath pleased Almighty God to be-
stow upon me & give me & spare thereof as followeth.

- Item I desire that all my ~~great~~ debts be paid & funeral Charges
- Item I give & bequeath three of my Land Plantations to Mrs. the Cur-
ter during her natural life, & after at the day of her death, I give
I give the same to my Cousin James Marshallburn
- I give & bequeath to Martha Carter, one feather bed, two Shirts
a Blanket, & two Cowstons & a pair, eighteen Guinea four barrels
of Beans, one Iron Pot, one water Pail, one pewter Plate, three Plates,
three Spoons, three knives & forks

As the residue & Remains of my Estate Good & Chattels within
without doors, my will & desire is for it to be sold for money
the money Equally divided among my Brothers & Sisters Children
And I do constitute & appoint my Friend James Butler & my
Cousin James Marshallburn my whole sole Executors of this my last
will & Testament & nothing & making & doing all other
Wills heretofore made by me. In witness where of I have here-
unto set my hand & seal this 10th day of August 1770.
