Mary Stuart Will

In the name of god Amen I Mary Stuart of the County
of Hampton in the province of North Carolina
being of perfect mind and memory thanks be given
to almighty god for the same but feeling certain
the uncertainty that attend's my ^{body} and it is appointed
for all men Creeds to die do make and Constitution
and Ordain this my last will and testament in
manner and following Viz first of all I commit
my soul into the hands of almighty god that
gave it hoping through the merits death and
passion of my savior Jesus Christ to have
full and free pardon and Remission of my sins
and my body I commit to the earth to be buried
in Christian like manner at the
discretion of my executors hereafter named and
as to such worldly estate as it hath pleased almighty
god to bestow upon me I give and bequeath
in manner and form following Viz

Item first of all my will and desire is that all my
debts and funeral charges shall be paid and
discharged

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca
the sum of five shillings upon my also
Sarah Withhall as heiress

Virginia money and all the rest of my Estate
I have to be sold at public sale and the money
arising to be equally amongst the rest of my
children as they survive of age to wit Anne Stuart
James Stuart James Stuart
I Lather Stuart

Item I do hereby testify and appoint Mr. William
Williams & William Stuart my full and whole
and sole Executors of this my last will and
testament

Item I do hereby make disclaim and void all other
wills and testaments by me heretofore made and
acknowledge this to be my last in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 25th day of Sept in the year of our Lord
1778 signed and delivered
