and to be Christian like manner at the

Item first of all my will and desire is that all my  
debt and funeral charges shall be paid and  
discharged  
Then I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rachael

Virginia money and all the rest of my Estates  
I leave to be sold at publick sale and the money  
aizing to be equally amoungst the rest of my  
children as they seeame of age to vise them that

& either Attenton

Now I do hereby Ordene and appoint the other  
Williams & Williams to be my full and whole  
and sole Executrix of this my last will and
