Now I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary
Hart all that part of my Estate that at my death
shall that I enjoy By marriage of her to her and
her heirs for ever.

I also give unto my beloved Wife Mary Hart my
Sonne Mores one Saw & eight Pepp Ten Barrels of Corn
to her and her heirs for ever.

I do constitute and appoint my beloved Wife Mary
Hart and Lawrence Smith my sole and sole
Executors of this my last Will and Testament
making void & disannulling all Wills By me
heretofore made In witness whereof I have

heretofore set my hand and seal this twentieth day of
April Anno Dom. One thousand Seven Hundred and
Seventy Seven

North Carolina Northampton County

In the Name of God Amen this 23rd day of September 1775
I James Turner of the County & Province of North Carolina
being sick in body But of good sound memory thanks be to almighty
God for it calling to remembrance the uncertainty
this Estate of this transitory life and that all flesh must
return to Death when it shall please God to call do make
Constitute ordain and this my last will and Testament
In manner and form following Revoking and annull-
ing by these presented all and every Testament and
Testaments Will & Wills heretofore by me made and
declared either By word or writing and this to be
Taken only for my last will Testament and none other
I give & bequeath unto my son Harmon Turners the sum of
five Shillings I give & bequeath unto my Daughter
Martha Lewis & Mary Warder & Sarah Ann
son one negro girl called a Phillis to be divided equally
among them & if when the Children come to age if
they cannot agree the negro must be sold
I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Susan Howell
the sum of five Shillings I bequeath unto my son

- Billison I reserve a certain Tract of Land Contain-
ing 220 Aers more or less Beginning at my Corner
on the fork of the horse meadow Branch & thence
to the head of flowers Branch to a long flowers branch
to a shallow mill Swamp & along the mill Swamp to
Harmon Hills Corner & along the W. side Line to
Mathews Buffons Line & along the W. Buffons Line
to J. Sams Sams Line & along the W. Sams Line to Edmunds
Line & along the W. Edmunds Line to the first Station.
- I Beque unto my son James Jarver one Tract of Land
Containing one hundred thirty Aers more or less Be-
ginning at the W. Billisons Corner & along Edmunds
Line to Billison Line & along his Line to his Corner
on head of flowers Branch.
- I Beque unto my son Benjamin Jarver a tract of Land
Containing one hundred & eighty Aers more or less
Beginning on Mathews Line on the South side of the
Swamp running along Mathews Line to James
Parsons Line & along the W. Parsons Line to his
Corner a pine & along Stantons Line to the Swamp
& along the Swamp to the first Station.
- I give unto my two sons Micajah Jarver & Thomas
Jarver my old manure Plantation to be Equally
Divided between them.
- I give & Beque unto my sons Billison & James Jarver
one negrow woman Called Cate after my wife
Widow Wood.
- I Beque unto my son Benjamin Jarver & Charlotte
Jarver one negrow garb Called Sam after
my wife Widow Wood.
- I Beque unto my two sons Micajah & Thomas Jarver
one negrow man Called Sam after my wife Widow
Wood.
- I Beque unto my Daughter Silviata Jarver one
negrow garb Called Ann.

I Beque unto my Daughter Mary Jarver one negrow
Called Sarah.

I Beque unto my wife Lucy all my Stock and house
hold goods During her widowhood & after her de-
cease all the Stock & house hold goods to be
Equally Divided among my five sons if they can agree
to divide among them or if not they must sell
it at public sale & divide the Money
of hereunto I set my hand & seal this day & date
above mentioned

In the name of God Amen Elizabeth Thomas of
Northampton County in the province of North Carolina
being at present Sick and weak of Body but of sound
mind and memory thanks be to God therefore but Calling
to mind the mortality of my body do constitute this my
last will and Testament in manner and form fol-
lowing that is to say first and principally I Commit
my soul into the hands of God hoping to have full
and free pardon of all my sins and to inherit ever-
lasting life as for my body I Commit it to the
Ground to be Buried in a Christian manner
at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named
and as touching all such Temporal Estate as it hath plea-
sed Almighty to bestow upon me I give & dispose thereof as follows
