& along the Swamp to the first Station.

I give unto my two sons Micajah Tarror & Thomas
Tarror my old manure Plantation to be Equally
Divided between them.

I give & Beque unto my sons Billion & James Tarror
won negrow woman Called Cate after my wife
Widow Wood.

I Beque unto my son Benjamin Tarror & Charlotte
Tarror our onck negro garb Called Sam after
my wife Widow Wood.

I Beque unto my two sons Micajah & Thomas Tarror
our negrow man Called Sam after my wife Widow
Wood.

I Beque unto my Daughter Silviata Tarror one
negro garb Called Ann.

I Beque unto my Daughter Betty Tarror one negro boy
Called David.

I Beque unto my wife Lucy all my Stock and house
hold goods During her widow wood & after her wi-
dow wood all the Stock & house hold goods to be
Equally Divided among my five sons if they can agree
to divide among them wite if not they must sell
it at public sale & divide the Money.

Northampton County in the province of North Carolina
being at present Sick and weak of Body but of sound
mind and memory thanks be to God therefore but Calling
to mind the mortality of my body do constitute this my
last will and Testament in manner and form fol-
lowing that is to say first and principally I Commit
my soul into the hands of God hoping to have full
and free pardon of all my sins and to inherit ever-
lasting life as for my body I Commit it to the
Ground to be Buried in a Christian manner
at the discretion of my Executor here after named
and as touching all such Temporal Estate as it hath plea-
sed Almighty to bestow upon me I give & dispose thereof as follows

Item I give to my grandson Samuel Bryan one dollar
I give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my whole
Estate within Doors and without Doors to be Equally
divided according to Equality between my two Daughters
Elizabeth Brown and Manning Benn and I do
Constitute my Trusty friend Daniel Dickinson and
John Dickinson my whole and sole Executors of this my
last will and Testament Resolving and making
void all other wills heretofore made by me in
Witness whereof I have unto set my hand and appear
my seal this thirty day of July 1773.

Harmon Jarver's Will

In the name of God Amen I Harmon Jarver of the County
Northampton in North West Parish living in good health
thanks be to God but duly Considering that it is approp-
riated and for all men to die do make this my last will
and Testament in manner and form as follows I think
proper as for my worldly Estate when with it hath pleased
God to bless me with I give and dispose of the
same as followeth first I give and bequeath the use
of my Plantation whereon I now dwell Contain-
ing one hundred acres of land thereto belonging
to the same more or less to my youngest son Robert
Jarver to him and his heirs forever. Secondly I give
to my son Frederick Jarver my Negro Boy Charles
to him and his heirs forever likewise my mare
to my son Frederick Jarver also with my Negro
