I give the use of my Plantation wher on I now live to my beloved
Wife during her life or widowers, also all the Crop that is on my
Plantation to raise & educate my children or else the use of my
other Plantations together with all my negro & stock till my
Eldest Daughter comes of age or many & as all the Children comes
of age my desire is that they may have their several Servants
hereafter to be mentioned, and in case my wife shall leave me
before my Children comes of age then my wife's desire is
that she shall my mrs Charles to be at his own Disposal, also
one feather bed furniture all the kitchen furniture &
one desk & table.

Item I give my worth unto my daughter Mary Long one negroe
called Millie one fiddy one feather bed of furniture to her
hairs forever.

Item I give my worth unto my Daughter Elizabeth Long one negroe
called Betsy feather bed of furniture to her hairs forever.

Item I give my worth unto my Daughter Susannah Long one negroe
called Edy, one feather bed of furniture to her hairs forever.

Item I give my worth unto my son James Long his Chain of one half
of my lands which was formerly being Harry & also half of the
land I bought of God almighty which is to be divided by
my self hereafter to be mentioned also two negroes named
Sam & Peter to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give my worth unto my son Richard Long the other half of
my land which was formerly owned by being Harry & James
also two negroes named Hartwell & Nelson to him &
his heirs forever.

Item I give my worth unto my son Robert Long the plantation when
in I now live with all the land I bought of Robert like, & others
Curious Cook also two negroes named Sam & Adam to him &
his heirs forever.

Item my further will & desire is that all the remainder part of my
Estate which I now will divide equally divide amongst

all my Children when my Daughter Mary Long comes of age, Also
do nominate & appoint my friends Hawkin Edmunds, James
Sunday & Thomas Branch my whole & dear Executors of this my
last will & testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & affix my seal this first day of October 1781.

Arthur Tyner's Will

In the name of God amen I Arthur Tyner of Northampton County
in the Province of Carolina being of perfect mind & memory
thanks be to God for it do make constitute & ordain this to be my last
will & Testament in manner & form following viz.

Item First of all my wife & desire is that all my little funeral charges
shall be paid & discharged

Item I give unto my Mother Elizabeth Tyner two hundred acres of land
at the place called Brashapone during her natural life

Item I give unto my Brother Nicholas Tyner forty five head of swine
one Cow & yearling one Jacket & Nelson, also young broadcloth
two ards & one horse, five dollars in small cash one linen number six
one pair of shear four hours an gallon & half of Brandy, one note
of hand of Benj Tindall & one note of hand of David Johnston
& two silver rings.

Item I give unto my brother George Tyner one Sow & pig, one young foal
one saddle bridle, one grubbing hoe, two axes & one adzey has one
measter at & two for 12 months one bond one for 12 months

Item I give unto my Mother Elizabeth Tyner one sheep & a lamb
ten barrels one barrel

Item I give unto my Sister Priscilla Tyner one black silk Hand
kerchief one Dozen one dozen Dollars

Item I give unto my Sister Sarah Tyner one Lamb one Linen Band
 Item I give unto my Sister Meletie one feather bed & a corn lurn.
 Item I give unto my Brother Dow Tyner one Hidng coat the bar
 rde of Corw.
 Item I give unto my Brother Nicholas Tyner fifteen barrels of Corn
 & all the remainder of my Corn at the place called Brushy Pond
 I to be equally divided among the two Black Stocks to Nicholas
 at the same place two to Dow Tyner at the same place I give
 also to Dow Tyner six hogs.
 Item I give unto my Mother Elizabeth Tyner sixteen of strong Hogs
 & all the rest of my Estate I leave to be Equally Divided between
 my Mother Brothers & Sisters except John Tyner & Wm Tyner
 I do hereby Constitute & Appoint my Brother Nicholas Tyner & William
 Sherwood full & whole sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testa
 ment I do hereby make Bevan & Baird another Will &
 testamant by me heretofore made & acknowledge this to be my
 last In witness whereunto I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 this 23rd of December in the Year of our Lord 1781.

 attends every body doth appointe for all men to say &
 make a Constitution this to be my last will & Testament in manner
 from following first of all I commend my soul into the hands
 of Almighty God that giveth hope through the death
 mits happiness of my Saviour Jesus Christ Whom full &

from this world I commend of my Soul to thy body I commit to
 the Earth to be buried decent Christian like manner at the Dis
 cretion of my executors Hereafter named Next to such worldly
 Estate as it hath pleased God almighty to bestow upon I give
 my Heirath in manner of form following
 Item first of all my wife & Belie is that all my debts & funeral
 charges shall be paid & discharged.
 Item I give my Heirath unto my beloved wife Anne Long my Hidng Horse
 Item I give unto my son John Long that Due of Land lying the new branch
 of Tyner line containing four hundred & Sixty acres bearing date
 of february the 18th 1754. I also give unto my son John Long
 two negroes Nick Bluke two Cows & Calves one horse to keep at
 the age of twenty one years
 Item I give unto my son Frederick Long all the remainder part of my
 Lands every other also two negroes named Chang & Jacob
 also Two Cows & also also one horse to keep at the age of twenty
 one years.
 Item I give unto my Daughter Mary Long two negroes named Rose
 Sarah also two Cows & Cales to keep at the age of eighteen years
 or marriage.
 Item I give unto my wife Anne Long three negroes named Kader
 Jenny & York during her natural life or widowhood also the use
 of the Children negroes while they come of age of my wife
 Shantia & Mary, and if she should marry
 Item my executors to take them their out for the use of my Children
 I also gave the three negroes that I left to my wife Kader Jenny
 York, to be Equally Divided between my two Sons John Long &
 Frederick Long & daughter Mary Long at the decease of my wife.
 I give unto my Son John Long & Frederick Long & my Daughter
 Mary Long each of them a feather bed of furniture I also give unto my
 wife one feather bed of furniture, I also leave unto my wife
 the use of all the remainder part of my Estate during her natural
 life or widowhood if my wife Shantia marry or die then to
 be Equally Divided between my three Children John Long
 Frederick Long & Mary Long.
