Wm. Gyners Will

In the name of god Amen I William Gyners of
the County of Hampshire in the Province of New Hampshire
being of perfect mind & memory thanks be given to
Almighty god for the same call me to mind the
mortality that attend my body & it is appointed for
all men once to die do make and constitute and
constitute in this to be my last will & testament
in manner & form following viz. First of all
I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty
god that gave it hoping through the merits death
& Passion of my Saviour Jesus Christ to have
full and free pardon and Remission of my sins
and my body I commend to the Earth to be buried
decent and Christian like manner at the discretion
of my Executors hereafter named as to such
movable estate as it hath placed Almighty God to
upon me I give and bequeath in manner
& form following viz.

Then first of all my will and desire is that all my debts
and funeral charges ^{shall} be paid and discharged

Then I give and bequeath unto Bess Gyners four shillings & six pence
Then I give unto my daughter Martha Gyners four shillings & six pence
Then I give unto my son Arthur Gyners four shillings & six pence

Then I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Davis four shillings & six pence

Then I give unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Gyners the third
part of all the third of any negroes or slaves owned
now or then the third of my land also the third of all the
rest of my Estate during her widowhood and if she
should marry then to have but a child part and
after my wife decease or in case she should marry

I then give unto my son Bess Gyners my negroes
named Mears and if any wife should marry or die

I then give my wife my daughter Sarah Gyners juster
Gyners & Milla Gyners my Will

Then I give unto my three sons to wit Arthur Gyners Wm Gyners
& Dore Gyners that part of land called the pine woods

Containing six hundred & forty acres more or less to be
equally divided among my three sons Arthur Gyners

& Dore the upper part called the Beech forest to
Arthur Gyners the lower part called the turkeys Old field

to Wm Gyners and the Spring part to the land
I now live on called Bitters to Dore Gyners & Elizabeth

of them my said sons Arthur Wm. or Dore should
die without issue the said part of land to be

equally divided between the other two and likewise
if Dore should die without issue one to have the half

& if they all should die without issue I leave the
said part of land to be equally divided between my

four daughters to wit Mary Gyners Sarah Gyners juster
Gyners Milla Gyners & if either of them should die

without issue the equally divided among the
rest of my said daughters here mentioned & also

all the rest of my Estate to be equally divided among

The rest of my children to wit. Mary Gyner

In the name of god Amen this thirly first day of
 January One thousand seven hundred and Eighty
 four I Joshua Daughtery of Northampton County
 being sick and weak in body and calling to mind
 the uncertain state of this transitory life that
 I must submit to death when it is pleased the
 Lord to call and am in perfect mind and memory
 thanks be to god for the same and I do make
 this my last will and testament in
 manner and form following that is to say first
 of all that all my Just debts to be paid first
 I lend the use of my plantation and negroes and all
 my Estate to my beloved wife Elizabeth Daughtery
 during her natural life and after death

I give and bequeath to my grand Children that
 proved from my daughter Lucrecia Campbell
 the wife of William Campbell five shillings
 at being their part of my Estate to them
 and their heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my daughter Anna Howell
 the wife of Stephen Howell five shillings
 of my Estate to her & her heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my son Eleajah Daughtery
 five shillings to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my son Olisha Daughtery
 five shillings at being his part of my Estate
 to him & his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my grand Daughter
 Elizabeth Sattins the daughter of Bury Sattins
