

in my Lands which they or any of them hold or claim by
 Title from or under me, then from & immediately after my said
 Daughter Elizabeths & dying or my said wife Mary making
 such refusal during or disturbing as aforesaid the said Legacy
 of 615 Acres of Land bought of George Lambkins & twelve
 Shaves before named, herein devised & bequeathed to my said
 Daughter Elizabeth shall be as & to the same & to the same attaint
 void, then & from thenceforward, I give the said Negro such
 Annua with her Manages to my son & sister his heirs & assigns
 forever, and the other eleven Negroes & the said 615 Acres of Land,
 I give & devise to my two sons Allen & Miller equally between
 them to be divided than & share alike to them their heirs &
 assigns forever.

It is my will & desire that my wife Mary shall be Guardian
 to my said Daughter Elizabeth, but if my said wife shall die
 before my said Daughter shall arrive at the age of twenty one,
 then I appoint my son Allen her Guardian.

I then I give & devise to my son Miller three hundred acres of Land
 in Oceanusky neck which I lately bought of Henry
 Jones & five hundred & odd Acres of Land in Baltimore County
 for which I bargained with Solomon Alston but
 have not got a title thereto, which Lands I give to my said
 son Miller his heirs & assigns forever.

I then I give & bequeath my Millator down another to my son Miller
 his heirs & assigns forever.

I then I give & bequeath unto my son Miller all my English Household
 furniture (Plate excepted), which is before given to my son Allen
 to remain in & pass to him with my Hand on Oceanusky taking
 his heirs & assigns forever, & it is my Express will & desire
 that all the rest of my furniture of what nature or kind soever
 or shall be sold & the money applied towards payment of my debts.

I then all the rest & residue of my Estate both real & personal of what
 nature or kind soever, not before specifically disposed of after
 payment of my just debts, I give & bequeath unto my two sons Allen
 & Miller equally between them to be divided than & share a
 like to them their heirs & assigns forever.

Lastly It is my will & desire that this present Codicil be annexed to
 & made part of my last will & testament, to all intent & purposes
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand & seal this
 twentieth Day of September 1766

 witnesses thereto at the same time Joseph John Alston -
 Allen Jones & Miller Jones were qualified as Executors thereof
 which was ordered to be Certified & Recorded
 Into Willm Jones C. C.

In the Name of God Amen the 10th day of July
 in the Grace of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred
 and sixty six I Moors Vial of Northampton County in the
 Province of North Carolina being between body but of
 sound and perfect Senes Mind and Memory thanks be to
 the almighty God for the same do make and declare
 this my last will and Testament here by recomman-
 ding of my soul unto the hands of my Redeemer
 and my body to be buried at the
 discretion of the Minister after married & as
 touching of my worldly Estate wherewith it
 has pleased almighty God to bless me withal give
 & dispose of the same in the following manner my just
 debts & funeral expenses being first paid by my
 said Executors Viz.

Item I give devise & bequeath unto my beloved Mother Mother
Wale all my Estate of all kinds during his natural Life &
after his decease I give devise & bequeath unto each of my
sister Patience Lockhart's four Children viz John Lock
hart Samuel Lockhart & Mary Lockhart & Anna Lockhart
fourty Pounds Virginia Currency to be paid out of my said
Estate after the decease of my said Mother to them their heirs & assigns

Item I also give devise & bequeath after the decease of my said Mo
ther unto my kinswoman Mary Livingston my negro Boy named
Shasper & my young black Horse, two Cows & calves four ewes
& lambs & six pullets & also two sows & pigs two peewee Dishes
& two Basins one Iron Pot & forty Pounds Virginia Currency to
her & to her heirs & assigns forever.

Item after the Decease here in my will given away be made good
I give devise & bequeath all the residue of my said Estate after
the decease of my said Mother to my said Brother Richard
Wale both Real & Personal to him & to his heirs & assigns forever

Lastly I do hereby nominate & constitute & ordain my said Brother
Richard Wale my whole sole Executor of this my last will and
Testament hereby Revoking & making null & void all former
wills & Testaments by me made & this only to be my last will &
Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& affix my Seal the day & year herein before written,
signed sealed published & delivered by the }

Isaac Dickinson's Will

In the name of God amen, the twenty first day of
November in the year of our Lord God 1766, Isaac

Dickinson of Northampton County in North Carolina
being very sick of body but of perfect mind and
sound memory thanks be given to God therefor calling to
mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to dye, do make and
ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say,
principally & first of all I recommend my soul
into the hands of God that gave it & for my body
I recommend it to the earth to be buried in a Chris
tianlike & decent manner at the discretion of my
Executors, nothing doubting but that at the general
Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
mighty power of God & as touching such worldly
Estate where with it has pleased God to bless me with
in this life, I give devise & dispose of the same in
the following manner & form --

Item 1 I give & bequeath to my Wife Priscilla Dickinson
the use of all my land & her life, also three negroes,
to her own disposal, to dispose of in like manner as
she sees fit, Hardy, Tom, Doll, Rose, Cote, Dinah,
Bot, Dennis, Phoebe & old Bessy Greene, also my whole
Stock horses, cattle, Sheep, Swine, & hogs, all my house
hold furniture & all the rest of my Estate --

Item 2 I give & bequeath unto my Brother David Dickinson
after my Wife's death a piece of Land beginning at the
mouth of the little Branch running along the Branch
to the head thereof a right straight to the head line
in the Folley Porcosen --

Item I give & bequeath to my Cousin Isaac Dickinson
to Daniel Dickinson all the rest of my Land where
on I now live to him & his heirs forever --

Item I give & bequeath unto my Cousin James Dickinson
two Acre and twenty Acres of Land in the Ford
County to him & his heirs forever --

Item I give & bequeath unto my Cousin John Dickinson
