them to be divided than shall alike to them their heirs &  
assigns forever.

It is my will & desire that my wife Mary shall be guardian  
to my said Daughter Elizabeth, but if my said wife shall die  
before my said Daughter shall arrive at the age of twenty one,  
then I appoint my son Allen her Guardian.

Item. I give & devise to my son Willie three hundred acres of Land  
in Oceanusby, neck which I lately bought of Henry  
Jones six hundred & odd acres of Land in Bute County  
for which I bargained with Solomon Atston for but  
have not got a title thereto, which lands I give to my son  
Allen his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give & bequeath my Illumator Stow Austin to my son Willie  
his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Willie all my English Household  
furniture, Plate &c, which is before given to my son Allen  
to remain in & pass to him with my Household Oceanusby to him  
his heirs & assigns forever & it is my express will & desire  
that all the rest of my furniture of what nature or kind soever  
or shall be sold & the money applied towards payment of my debts  
Item all the rest & residue of my Estate both real & personal & whatso  
ever or kind soever not before specifically disposed of after  
payment of my just debts, I give & bequeath unto my two sons Allen &  
Willie equally between them to be divided than shall alike  
to them their heirs & assigns forever.

Allen Jones & Willie Jones were qualified executors thereof  
which was ordered to be Certified & Recorded

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Mother Miltie Hale all my Estate of all kinds during her natural life & after her decease I give devise & bequeath unto each of my sister Palmer Lockhart & four Children viz John Lockhart, Hart, Samuel Lockhart & Mary Lockhart & Anna Lockhart forty Pounds Virginia Currency to be paid out of my said Estate after the decease of my said Mother to them their heirs or assigns  
 Item I also give devise & bequeath after the decease of my said Mother to my kin woman Mary Livingston my negro Boy named Sharp & my young black Horse, two Cows & calves four Ewes & Lambs & a Pewter Plates two Cowspikes two Pewter Dishes & two Basins one Iron Pot of forty Pounds Virginia Currency to her to her heirs & assigns forever.

Item after the Legacys herein my wife given away be made good I give devise & bequeath all the residue of my said Estate after the decease of my said Mother to my said Brother Richard Hale both Real & Personal to him & his heirs & assigns forever

Hale I do hereby nominate & constitute & ordain my said Brother Richard Hale my whole sole Execut of this my last will and Testament hereby Revoking & making null & void all former wills & testaments by me made & this only to be my last will & testament. Isaac Dickinson's Will

In the name of God amen, the twenty first day of November in the year of our Lord God 1766, Isaac

Item 1 I give & bequeath to my wife Priscilla Dickinson the use of all my land & her life, also these negroes, to her own disposal, to dispose of in like manner as she sees fit, Hardy, Tom, Doll, Rose, Cole, Dinah, Bob, Dennis, Henor & old Barn hinc, also my whole Stock horses, cattle, Sheep, Geese, Hogs, all my House hold furniture & all the rest of my Estate -

Item 2 I give & bequeath unto my brother David Dickinson after my wife death a piece of Land, beginning at the mouth of the little Branch running along the Branch to the head thereof right straight to the head line in the Tolley Possession -

Item 3 I give & bequeath to my cousin Isaac Dickinson to Daniel Dickinson all the rest of my Land which we now live to him & his heirs forever -

Item 4 I give & bequeath unto my cousin James Dickinson two hundred & twenty acres of Land in the Ford Country to him & his heirs forever -

Item 5 I give & bequeath unto my cousin Ann Dickinson
