Requiring my estate may not be appraised

thousand seven hundred and seventy six.

sold and the money arising to discharge my debts

Item I bind to my loving wife the use of all my Estate to main-
tain my daughter Angelina Clark Maddill until
she arrives at the age of six ten years.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Angelina Clark
Maddill the plantation whereon I now live and negroes
servt, Lucy, Mingo, George, Simon and Reuben and half
of my house holder furniture and to be possessed with
them at the age of sixteen years to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to my loving wife my negroes to wit Sarah, Kit,
and Hannah to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give likewise to my wife all the rest of my Estate
Be it of what value or kind so ever to her and her heirs
forever My will and desire is that if my daughter
Angelina Clark Maddill depart this life before
she arrives to the age of sixteen years that my nephew
Thomas Maddill enjoy her part so deceased and I
do nominate and appoint James Clark Hloom Smith
Ethelinda Ruffin my executors of this my last will
and testament In witness whereof I have set my
hand and seal this 1st day of December in the year
of our Lord 1775
