whitney, at same time Leah Hollaway was also qualified
executrix of the same. & ordered no motion to be certified

Childless Washington's Will

In the name of God aman. I Racheland Washington of North-
ampton County Province of North Carolina, being very sick
& weak in body, but in my perfect sense & memory, promise
to god first, & calling to mind the mortality of my body, &
knowing that it is ordained for all men to die, do make
constitute & ordain this my last will & Testament, revoking
& revoking all other wills & testaments whatsoever hitherto
made by me.

Impunit, I give & bequeath my soul to god that gave it me, relying
on the merits of my blood & barren to have full remission
of all my sins, & my body to the earth to be buried at the
discretion of my executors hereafter named.

Item I give & bequeath unto my Brother John Washington that
part of my land (that is where I now live) joining Kirby's
Cruck, that is from whence it goes the said John Washington's
land in the said Cruck, then up the said Cruck to where it
strikes Richard Andrews line, then along the said Andrews
line until it crosses the left prong of his said boundary.

Then up said Prong or branch until it strikes the Country
road, then down the said road, until it comes to the
said John Washington's land, and I likewise give him all
his dues & demands due from him to me, and I also give
him the Cows that are bought of the estate.

Item I give & bequeath to my brother Nichols Washington the re-
mainning Part of the said tract of land, and one Negroe
fellow named Lewis, on condition that he the said Nichols
Washington pay unto his mother Joyce Washington yearly
four hundred weight of merchantable Pork & lard the
his said Mother shall live, without the said Negro & if first
then he is exempted from the said payments, & I give him one
cleaning Broad Cloth Coat, & half my Shirts & the other half
I give to John Washington

Item I give & bequeath unto my sister Joyce Washington one Negroe
fellow called Charles on condition that she pay unto her
Mother Joyce Washington two hundred weight of good
merchantable Pork yearly abling as her said Mother
shall live, without the said Negroe shall die first, then
she is exempt from the said Payments.

Item I give & bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Washington two
ty pound Virginia money & one riding horse, in provisio that
she pay unto my executors four Pounds Virginia Currency,

Item I give & bequeath unto my Brother Robert Washington my
silver watch which is now at the Slave Bonds, & Dely in
Halifax on provisio that he pay for the mending the said watch
& my burstant.

Item I give & bequeath unto my brother Benjamin Washington my
Coat & breeches at Dares Fieretts & he is to pay for the making
the same, and my blue broad cloth jackets & likewise give
him his note of hand that I have of him and all other debts due
from him to me.

Item I give & bequeath unto my Sister Joanna Thompson one
feather bed after the death of her mother.

Item I give & bequeath unto James Denton of Hertford County five Pounds
Virginia money.

Item I give & bequeath unto Richard Andrews son of Richard Holland.
 Item I give & bequeath unto William Mayow my part of the Cloth
 Ironmills &c, that Benjamin Washington & I was of his, & also
 that broad Cloth that is my Part, that Thomas Boddings is now
 of his.
 Item I give & bequeath unto my Mother Joyce Washington the sum
 of my bed & Curing her life.
 Item I give & bequeath unto Thomas Edmund my two knuckle buckles
 Item I give & bequeath unto Elizabeth Pearce my Provisions she keeps
 now this year out of five barrels of Indians Corn & Shuckers
 give her up her annuities
 Item and my will & desire is that all my Estate not given away
 after my debts are paid, to be equally between my Mother
 Joyce Washington and my brother John Washington
 and I do hereby constitute & appoint my Brother John
 Washington and my trusty friend Thomas Edmunds
 my two Executors of this my last Will & Testament. In
 witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & fared my
 seal this 31st day of March 1768.

William Brooks Will

In the Name of God Amen. I William Brooks of Northampton
 County in the Province of North Carolina, being sick & in
 a declining Condition, but of sound perfect memory, do
 make & Ordain this to be my last Will & Testament in man-
 ner of person following right, first I recommend my soul to
 Almighty God, then God, & my body to be decently buried

at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned & touching
 my worldly estate I give & bequeath as follows
 Item I give & bequeath to my Grandson Richard Hodges all the Land
 Plantation I now have or after the death of my Daughter
 Joyce Brooks, to him his heirs forever. & in Case the said Hodges
 dies without an heir lawfully begotten then my will desirous
 is that the land Plantation should be equally divided between
 Robert Rutherford & William Melton their heirs forever
 Item I give & bequeath to my Grand Daughter Mary Hodges one
 Negro Girl named Sarah & all her increase to her till he is
 forced lawfully begotten of her, and in Case there should
 be a female she should die without Heir of her body
 my will & desire is that the said Negro & her increase should
 be given to her Sister Betty Hodges their heirs forever
 Item I give & bequeath unto my Son William Brooks one hundred ster-
 ling Money,
 Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Bourne one
 Shilling Sterling Money,
 Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Anna Hodges one shill-
 ing Sterling Money,
 Item My will & desire is that all the remainder of my Estate
 both real personal, & increase, before not mentioned
 after the death of Joyce Brooks, should be equally di-
 vided between Robert Rutherford & William Melton &
 their Heirs forever, at the discretion of my Executors, the
 said Robert Rutherford & William Melton shall have
 a Right to Thomas Williams of two hundred acres of land
 more or less being taken up in the same Survey I gave to
 Richard Hodges.

Item I leave to my Daughter Joyce Brooks three negroes named
 Peter Paul & Sam & all the remainder of my Estate during
 her life,
 and I do hereby appoint Robert Rutherford & William Melton
 my Executors to this my last Will & Testament, to distribute & Re-
 voke all other made before either by word or writing
