 - Item I give & bequeath unto my Brother Joseph Figuers all my wearing clothes.
 - Item I give & bequeath unto my Brother William Figuers four hundred acres of land that is joining his own the money that he is owing me.
 - Item I give to my three Daughters viz. Mary, Derring, Mary, & Elizabeth & their each ^{an} gold Ring with the Policy remember I Figuers, I also give unto my beloved Wife right Negro man nam'd Tom, Samly, Jack, Comp, Jacob, Man, J. & Maney & one Copper Still Cap, a Iron Still & Pump & after paying my Debts & Legacies I give her all the remaining part of my Estate.
 - Also I give my beloved Wife Mary Figuers whom I do likewise Com Statute make & ordain my only Heir & Executor of this my last will & Testament & I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke, annul, null, & every other former will & Testament & Legacy bequeath & Decretal by me in any way my life, the same name & will, bequeath'd, Reserving & Reserving my third & no other to be my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this the thirtieth day of September one thousand seven hundred & eighty.

- This will of John Figuers was exhibited in Court & proved by the oath of Arthur Sherrard & subscribed & attested at the same time Mary Figuers was Ensigne & a certificate of the same was ordered to be certified & recorded.

James Washingtons Will

In the name of God amen. I James Washington of Northampton County being sick & weak in body but in perfect sound & Memory praise be to the Almighty God for it but knowing the uncertainty of our being here do make this my last will & Testament as follows to wit

- Item I give & bequeath unto my soul to God that I may at my resting on the merits of my blessed Saviors to have full remission of all my sins & my body to the earth to be buried at the discretion of my Execut as hereafter named.
- Item I give unto my dear & loving wife one feather bed & one pair Blankets & Camps of shute & one Negro woman nam'd Grace & also the use of the plantation whereon I now live & the Labour of these Negroes, during her natural life that is Jerry Jacob & Sal & also the use of all the Horses, Cattle & Hogs during her natural life.
- Item I give & bequeath unto my son Robert Washington one hundred acres of land whereon he now lives to him & his heirs of his Body lawfully begotten & for want of such heirs to descend to my son Nicholas Washington & his heirs forever & also give my son Robert Washington one Negro fellow called Tom and one boy called Ralph to him and his heirs forever & also one Negro fellow called Jacob after the death of his mother.
- Item I give & bequeath unto my son Benjamin Washington two hundred acres of land being the plantation whereon I now live the land & hold of the other side of Ancher in New Northampton County to him & his heirs of his Body lawfully begotten & for want of such heirs to descend to Michael Washington & his heirs forever. I give to my son Benjamin Washington one Negro Boy called Roger & after the death of his mother one Negro man called James to him & his heirs forever & further my desire is that my son Robert Washington may have timber off the land over Ancher in Northampton County to build on his plantation if he desire.
- Item I give & bequeath unto my son John Washington his heirs forever two hundred acres of land on the South side of Kings Creek paying Arthur ^{William} ~~Washington~~ Land & give him one Negro

Boy Called Hill & one negro Boy Called Moll to him this time
forever.

Item I give the math unto my son Estlin Washington this time forever
two hundred acres of land on the south side of Turkey Creek join-
ing Richard Andersons Land and the Land of his Brother Johns
I give one negro Boy Called Lewis & one Called Charles
& I give him one feather Bed.

Item I give the math unto my son Nicholas Washington two hundred
acres of land to him this time forever lying on the north side of
Little Creek joining the said Creek & the Land I give his Bro-
ther Samuel Estlin I give him one negro Boy Called Full
& one negro Called Peter & I give one negro girl Called
Beck & I give him one feather Bed & a rug & bed.

Item I give unto my Daughter Joanna Tomson & her heirs
forever ninety acres of land being the plantation that she now
lives on I also give her a negro Woman Called Miss after
the death of her Mother I give her a Negro Woman Called Nell
to her this time forever also one Negro Boy Called Davy & after
the death of my said Daughter she said Negro Boy Davy
to my Grand son Estlin Tomson.

Item I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Washington one negro boy
Called Benck & one negro girl Called Lucy to her this time
forever & I give her one Feather Bed & rug & bed.

Item I give unto my Daughter Jope Washington this time forever one
negro girl Called Dinor & one negro Boy Called Phil & I give her
one feather Bed & rug & bed & one gold Ring.

Item I give unto my Granddaughter Mary Sandy one Negro boy named
Lukes & one negro boy Called Arthur on the proviso that she live
to the age of eighteen years old or married if not the said
negro to be equally divided amongst the rest of my Children.

My will & desire is that my negro Willard Frank may be sold to pay
my just debts by my Executors here after named & all the remaining
part of my estate to be equally divided amongst all my Children
after the death of their Mother I do constitute & appoint my
son Robert Washington Boy Washington John Washington

Estlin Washington & my son in Law Charles Tomson whole
& sole Executors of this my last will & testament as witness my
hand & seal this 5th Day of December 1764

This will of James Washington dec'd was exhibited into Court & proved
by the subscribing witnesses, the same for Martha Washington & Elizabeth
Washington at the same time & that said Elizabeth & John
Washington were qualified as Executors thereof which is ordered
to be Certified & recorded.

Item I give to my brother Harwood Tomson my tract of land joining my
said Brothers plantation and a nearby Swamp to him this time
& forever forever provided that my said Brother do me pay my debts
in hundred pound Virginia Money within six months after my death
to the said Land shall be confirmed.

Item my will & desire is that my negroes continue on the said plantation
till the crop now growing there is finished & that then the money
arising from the sale thereof & all other money together with the stock
I also desire my negroes be appraised & that my brother Thomas
take his first choice at the appraisement if either of my other Brothers
things proper they may take any share at the appraisement also I give
two slaves that my personal estate before mentioned be equally
divided amongst all my Brothers & my sister Lydia & all my
