am of Northampton County in the State of North Carolina being sick &
weak of Body but of sound & perfect memory do make this my last
will & Testament in manner & form following.
Item I give & bequeath unto my son John Williams one Negro man Sam & one
Negro Girl Phyllis & her increase for aforesaid Likewise I give my daughter
Williams five acres of Cattle
Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Polly Williams one negro
boy & one negro girl Lucy & her increase for aforesaid Likewise I give
to my daughter Polly Williams five acres of Cattle
Item I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas Williams one negro James
& one negro Girl Gracia & her increase for aforesaid give to my
son Thomas Williams five acres of Cattle
Item I give & bequeath unto my son Brittain Williams one negro boy
Jerry & one by the name of aforesaid Likewise I give unto my son
Brittain Williams five acres of Cattle
Item I give & bequeath unto my son Wm Hart Williams two my rams
Jacob & Jim likewise I give to my son Wm Hart Williams five acres of Cattle
Item I leave to my beloved wife Martha Williams one negro woman called
Prop during of her life & after her decease the said Negro & her increase
to be equally divided between my four children Likewise I
likewise leave one negro woman named Anna & Solomon
during of her life or widowhood & after that to be equally
divided between my four Children Likewise I leave to my wife
one negro boy cuff during of her life or widowhood & after her
death or widowhood to be divided between my four Children
Likewise I give my wife Martha Williams a bed of furniture
said Stock Likewise my black horse & side saddle likewise give
my wife five acres of Cattle Likewise six acres of sheep
my wife to own & that my white horse Top & boy man & colt may
be kept for the use of my family.
Item I give & bequeath unto my four Sons John, Thomas, Brittain & William
Hart a plantation to be equally divided between the four boys but my will
& desire is that Elijah Hart may not be interrupted so long as she live
but may have a few privileges of my few lands on the River.

My will & desire is that soon orderly be sold the money be applied to the use of the family after my just debts are paid.
 My wished Desire is that my whole Estate be kept together as long as my father Thomas & Sarah Williams shall live. That they remain taintaind of the Estate as long as they live, & like wise authorise & appoint Edward, Sam'l, Haily, Brown & Thomas joint the sole & sole executors of this my last & last Will & Testament in all things whereto I have herunto set my hand & seal at the day & year above written sign'd & attested in presence of us. John Williams & seal

James Clark's Will

In the Name of God am - I James Clark of Maccuton County in North Carolina do make & ordain this my last & last Will & Testament by revoking all other wills heretofore by me made first of all I desire that my just debts be paid & may be decently buried at the discretion of god. Hereafter mentioned & for the rest of my Estate I give & dispose of in manner following viz, I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Cook my negro wife Ann with her increase with one bed & furniture to her & her heirs & assigns forever & give to my Daughter Mary Cook one negro slave & child by the name of Cate Hannah which she hath in her possession with their increase taken her heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give to my Daughter Charity Fennel one negro slave by the name of Little Anna with her increase also two Cows of about to her heirs & assigns forever

Item I give to my Daughter Sarah Jordan one negro fellow by the name of Little Harper also two Cows of about to her heirs & assigns forever

Item I give to my Daughter Angelina Clark two negro girls by the

names of Nettie & Tinah with their increase also one bed & furniture to her heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give to Daughter Nancy Clark one negro girl Dorothy & her increase also as much Cash as shall purchase to one other negro Girl of the age of fourteen also one bed & furniture to her heirs & assigns forever

Item I give to Daughter Nancy Clark two negroes by the name of Tom & Parry with her increase also one bed & furniture to her heirs & assigns forever

Item I give to Daughter Elizabeth Clark the negroes by the names of little Hannah Millie & Sonny with their increase also one bed & furniture of about twelve Pounds per week in Specie taken her heirs & assigns forever

Item I give to my Son James Watkins Clark all my land & all four negroes taught & let him brick & Imperil with their increase also one Bed & Furniture Table one bed & furniture three Stoves & iron looking glass one Case of Bottles one Gunne & one Chair of all the Household his mothers death or marriage to him his heirs & assigns forever

Item I give to my Grandson James Clark Fennel one year old Colt when he coms to the age of eight years old.

Item I give to my beloved wife thru a negro (sold) Great Master Great Hannah & Nancy & their increase to her heirs & assigns forever also one bed & furniture my children the uses of my land & plantation also the use of all my childrens negroes till they shall come to the age of twenty one or more & in case of their death I dole that all the rest of my Estate notwithstanding may be equally divided betwix all my children & wife increase the marriage. I nominate & appoint Isham Fennel & John Jordan executors of this my last & last Will & Testament in all things whereof I have herunto set my hand & affix my seal this third day of November 1782. signed, sealed & witness in presence of us James Clark and a male
