 whereon I now live, seven head of Cattle, one horse & all my tools
 one large pot & books one Iron Black one faying saw & one Miller

Item I give & give unto Sumner Tadlock one Cow & calf

Item I give & give unto Cousin James Galland the son of Edward
 Galland one Chest & one Dish one barn one Dish plate & one
 flat plate,

Item I give & give unto Cousin Ann Galland the daughter of John
 Galland one dozen about one pair of Cotton Carrots,

Item I give & give unto Cousin Sarah Galland the daughter of
 Edward Galland one Linen cloth,

Item I give & give unto my sister Charity Brett one small bed
 Turned bed & one two black hite Nave Shute,

Item I give & give unto my Cousin Edward Galland the son of
 Mrs Galland five Shillings & pence

Item I give the residue & remainder of my Estate as it shall be without
 Doors to Cousin James Galland the son of Mrs Galland & he
 nominate & appoint Joseph Johnson & Elisha Pusey my
 whole & sole Executors of this my last will & Testament making
 Disannulling & making void all other wills Heretofore made
 by me in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
 this 24th day of Sept 1782. Sarah ^{his} Galland & seal

In the name of God Amen the 22nd day of November 1782. I J. Williams
 of Northampton County in the State of North Carolina being sick &
 weak of Body but of sound & perfect memory do make the my last
 will & Testament in maner & form following.

Item I give & give unto my son John Williams one Negro man Samson
 Negro Girl Phillis & her increase for ever likewise I give my son John
 Williams five head of Cattle

Item I give & give unto my daughter Polly Williams one Negro
 boy Bob & one Negro Girl Lucy & their increase for ever likewise I give
 to my daughter Polly Williams five head of Cattle

Item I give & give unto my son Thomas Williams one Negro James
 & one Negro Girl Grace & their increase for ever & I give to my
 son Thomas Williams five head of Cattle.

Item I give & give unto my son Brittain Williams one Negro boy
 Jerry & one by the name of Andrew likewise I give unto my son
 Brittain Williams five head of Cattle.

Item I give & give unto my son Mrs Hart Williams two my sons
 Jacob & Sam likewise I give unto Mrs Hart Williams five head Cattle.

Item I bind to my beloved wife Martha Williams one Negro woman named
 Popsy during of her life & after her decease the said Negro & her increase
 to be equally divided between my five children likewise I
 likewise bind her one Negro woman named Hannah & her
 increase during of her life or widowhood & after that to be equally
 divided between my five children & likewise bind to my wife
 one Negro boy Cuffy during of her life or widowhood & after
 widowhood or death to be divided between my five children
 likewise I give my wife Martha Williams one bed & furniture
 said stock likewise my black horse & one saddle likewise I give
 my self five head of Cattle likewise six head of sheep
 my eldest son is that my white horse & one boy man & all may
 be kept for the use of my family.

Item I give & give unto my four sons John, Thomas, Brittain & William
 Hart all my lands to be equally divided between the four boys but my will
 & desire is that Elizabeth Hart may not be interrupted & so long as she lives
 but may have a free privilege of my four lands on the River

My will & desire is that once or twice by he sold the money be applied to the use of the family after my just debts are paid.

My Will & Desire is that my whole Estate be kept together as long as my father Thomas & Sarah Williams shall live. That they be maintained out of the Estate as long as they live, & be likewise authorized & appointed Edward Sawyer & Haily Broom & Thomas Joyner to be full & sole Executors of this my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 20th day of October 1782.

Witness the hands of the said Thomas Williams, Haily Broom, & Edward Sawyer 2 qualified Executors to the same, & to be Certified the said Just Joseph Atterlin &c

JAMES CLARK'S Will

In the name of God am I James Clark of Washington County North Carolina do make & ordain this my last will & Testament here by revoking all other wills heretofore by me made, first of all I desire that my just debts be paid & I may be decently buried at the discretion of Exrs. Hereafter mentioned & for the rest of my Estate I give & dispose of in the manner following (Viz) I give to my daughter Sarah Cook my negro which annexed to her Inheritance with one bed & furniture to her & her heirs & assigns forever I give to my daughter Mary Cook one negro which I give by the name of Cate Hannah which she hath in her possession with their Inheritance to her & her heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give to my daughter Charity Pennel one negro which by the name of Little with her Inheritance also one bed & furniture to her & her heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give to my daughter Sarah Jordan one negro which by the name of Little Harp, also two Cows & Horses to her & her heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give to my daughter Angelina Clark two negro girls by the

names of Notice & Tenah with their Inheritance also one bed & furniture to her & her heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give to daughter Harvey Clark one negro Girl Bonah & her Inheritance also as much Cash as shall purchase her one other negro Girl of the age of fourteen also one bed & furniture to her & her heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give to daughter Mary Clark two negroes by the name of Tom & Parry with her Inheritance also one bed & furniture to her & her heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give to daughter Elizabeth Clark three negroes by the names of little Hannah Melly & Tenney with their Inheritance also one horse of about twelve paces Prime in Spain to her & her heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give to my son James Watkins Clark all my lands also four negroes to wit Malt Lewis Brock & Implet with their Inheritance also one Bed Room Parlor Table one bed & furniture three sawd pigs one looking glass one case of Bottles one Guinea then also his choice of all the Horses at his death or marriage to him & his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give to my Grandson James Clark Pennel one year old Colt when he comes to the age of eight years old.

Item I give to my children Eliza Thra negro & to wit Great Harp & Great Hannah & Harvey & their Inheritance to her & her heirs & assigns forever I also leave her Inheritance to raise & school my children & the use of all my children & assigns till they shall come to the age of twenty one or married, & in right of whichsoever death I die that all the rest of my Estate not given may be equally divided between all my children & assigns & the manner I nominate & appoint Ephraim Pennel & Joseph Jordan Executors of this my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 20th day of November 1782.
