Lastly I appoint my Brother William Garrison whole Able Executor of this my last Will & Testament Discharging all that he, Executor shall have made by me of Money Money I have Received but may have I leave the way I hear some written

 of age the said Lady Robinson my Executors named hereby to have
 the said Estate for her then the balance of any remaining to be equally
 divided between my said Daughter Lady Robinson & the said
