

### William Burke's Will.

In the name of God Amen William Burke of Northampton County in the State of North Carolina being weak in body but in my mind sound and memory do make this my last Will and Testament, and first I command my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian like manner, at the discretion of my Executor, or trustees my willdy estate where with the Lord has blessed me with I give and bequeath of to the executors and my following way.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Isela Brooks the Land and plantation where she now lies, and the residue of my Land that I shall not mention hereunto and also my Negro Slave, Chavis, and Alia to him and his Heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my Grand son John Daughtry all my Land lying on the East side of the main road which is the plantation where James Daughtry now lies to him and his Heirs. —

Item. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sally Packhard her Negro Boy Rass and App. to her and her Heirs. —

Item. I had a daughter Betty Daughtry during her life, her Negro Boy Gibel and a child as after her death the said Negro with their convenience to be equally divided amongst all her children then living to them and their Heirs. —

Item. I stand unto my beloved wife Mary Burke during her natural life the House where I now live with one hundred acres of land adjacent to it above my Negro Bill, Chavis, & Catto and all my Stock of cattle Hogs and Sheep, and the House Dwelling and the old Stage and all the residue of my estate which I have not so shall not mention hereafter and after her death, I give the said House & the one hundred acres of land to my Daughter Sally Packhard, and the residue to be sold and equally divided amongst my three children vizt. Isela Burke, Betty Daughtry & Sally Packhard or their heirs. And it is my Will and desire that the sum of Land lying on the Beach should be sold and my just debts paid, and the balance if any to the use of my Daughtry Burke. — the other four articles. —

And I do hereby appoint Rushy Calleland Valley Banker my whole and sole Executrix and Executor of this my last Will and Testament and she hereby disown and renounce all and every other Will Testamente and by

whom ratifying and confirming this to be my last Will and Testament aboveunto I have written along hand and fixed my Seal this 22<sup>nd</sup> January A.D. Anno Dom. 1793. —

### William Daig's Will

In the name of God amen William Daig of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina being weak in health the better to be fit of a sound and delirious memory knowing the uncertainty of this life do after commanding my soul into the hands of Almighty God do give it me blessing for a portion of my son and my daughter in the house of my Brother Daughtry residence to be retained at their discretion before the year which it hath pleased him to dismiss me with in this life in manner and form following.

Item. I stand unto my beloved wife Daithy Daig the land and plantation where I now live during her natural life, also give her the privilege of getting back to her the said plantation in again off of the one hundred acres of land kept by my said wife, until my Daughter Betty Daig comes of age a minor.

Item. I give and bequeath the said one hundred acres of land to my Daughter Betty Daig, the residue of my estate to be used the uses longfity of her living and her offspring forever.

After the death of my wife Daithy Daig and bequeath the land plantation where I now live to my Daughter Betty to her, her lawful legitimate Heirs & offspring forever.

Item. I stand unto my living wife the use of the following Negro boy Adam Burke Vt and his increase during her natural life, I do least her the use of service and
