I Moses Byrd of the County of Northampton State of N Carolina being of perfect health of body and knowing that it is appetitive for all men once to do and make and ordain this my last Will & Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give & recommend my soul unto the keeping of Almighty God that gave it, & my body I commit to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly Estate wherewithal I hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give away and dispose of the same in the following manner: upon that is to say I give to my son Hilla Bush one score acres of land on Bull Calf & the rest of my estate is to be sold after my death, and my wife death, all my just debts are to be paid according to Law & the balance is to be equally divided between Hilla Bush & Mary Bush ratifying & confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this second day of January eighteen hundred eight signed sealed published pronounced & declared by the said Moses Byrd as his last Will & Testament in the presence of us who in the present in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names leaving Moses Byrd as my Executor to this Will.

I Philip Byrd of the County of Northampton State of N Carolina being very low in body & in perfect mind & memory of my body knowing that it is appetitive for all men once to do and make & ordain this my last Will & Testament that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul unto the keeping of Almighty God that gave it, & my body I commit to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God & as touching such worldly Estate I hath pleased God to bless me in this life.

I give unto my dear Farmer Bush my lands,

I give to Elizabeth Halden on Broadside N.Y. & the balance of my Estate is to be sold according to Law and all my just debts paid after that the balance is to be divided between Farmer Bush & Elizabeth Halden ratifying & confirming this and no other to be my last Will & Testament in writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this ninth of January 1805. Signed Sealed & delivered on the 9th day of January 1805 by the Testator in the presence of us
