to that age I then give it unto him. If he does not arrive to that
age my Will & devise is that all the said Estate be equally divided
between my Brothers William Par & Elizabeth. Mowbray & them their
Heirs &c.

Lastly I nominate & appoint Thos. J. Hudson and James Bradley my
witnesses to this my last Will & Testament in testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 28th day of October 1897
