

Jesse Daughtrey's Will.

In the name of God amen I Jesse Daughtrey of Northampton County in North Carolina being of sound mind and disposing memory do constate and affix my last will and Testament in manner and form following this Imprimis I leave to my beloved wife Shady Daughtrey the Negroes plantation wherein I now live and my Bed called Bed and a Filly called Pleasant her feather bed and furniture two Boxes three one and pigg, my Negroes man called Peank and a sufficiency of my plantation Utensils, and Kitchen furniture at the directions of my Executor herein mentioned also a sufficiency of my flocks and Stock for few years support of her and Children during her widowhood and after her Death or marriage I give all the above mentioned articles to be equally divided the said Plantation excepted between my Children Lawrence, Henry, Temperance Sarah and Pleasant Daughtrey to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my two Sons Joseph and Thomas Daughtrey the Land and Plantation wherein I now live including all the Lands of which I am proprietor to be equally divided between them when they come to lawfull age after my Wifes marriage or death but if my wife should marry a few before they come to age then in that case it is my desire the Lands be hired out till the oldest comes of age and the profits arising to equally divided between them, and in case that either of my said Sons Joseph or Thomas Daughtrey should die before they should arrive to lawfull age or have lawfull issue I give devise and bequeath all my lands herein mentioned to the survivor to him and his heirs or assigns forever.

Item I give unto my Son Joseph Daughtrey one Negro girl called Rachel and one hundred silver Dollars but in case he should die before he comes to lawfull age or have lawfull issue I give the above to my Son Thomas Daughtrey to him and his heirs or assigns forever.

Item I give unto my Son Thomas Daughtrey one Negro girl called Martha and one hundred silver Dollars but in case he should

die before he comes to lawfull age or have lawfull issue then I give the above mentioned Negro and money unto my Son Joseph Daughtrey to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Joseph Daughtrey Five shillings current money to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Charity Daughtrey Five pounds current money to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Shucky Daughtrey Five shillings to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Lawrence wife of Charles Lawrence five pounds current money to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son William Daughtrey Five pounds to him and his heirs forever.

It is my will that my Negroes Louis Cottley together with all the remainder of my estate of what kind soever not before given away be sold and equally divided between my children namely, Lawrence, Henry, Temperance, Sarah & Pleasant Daughtrey to them and their heirs forever. Lastly I do hereby nominate constate and affix my beloved Wife Shady Daughtrey and my two friends Thomas Cottlear & Sarah Outland while and in the Execution of this my last will and Testament revoking disannulling and making void all other and former wills by me heretofore made. This to be my last will and Testament At Wethers wharf above named I have executed set my Hand and seal this 1st day of January 1796 -
