

# Drury Deberry's Will.

In the name of God AMEN I Drury Deberry of Rockingham County in the State of North Carolina being sick and weak of body but of sound and perfect mind and memory thanks be to Almighty God for it, calling to mind the mortality of my body, knowing that it is appointed for all men to die to make and ordain this my last will and Testament, principally and first of all command my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent manner at the direction of my executors hereafter named and in providing such available estate wherewithal it has pleased God to bless me with power and suffice of in the form and manner following:

Item I cast the care of all the Land and plantation lying on the cabin branch and Kirby creek to my stepson Daughter Charlotte Holloman, until her son Thomas Debory Holloman come to the age of twenty one year, and after Thomas Debory Holloman come to the age of twenty one year, I give the said Land and plantation lying on the said cabin branch & Kirby Creek to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give to my stepson Grand son Thomas Debory Holloman all the Land and plantation whereon now lies also our slate that stands on the Land to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and my will and desire is that Drury Mabry should have all my son Thomas Deborys wearing clothes.

Item I give to my stepson Grand son Thomas Debory Holloman six Negro slaves by the names of Sam, Sam Champion, Ambrose, Dick, Tom, Drury Debory & Dicks. I give to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to my stepson Daughter Charlotte Holloman ten Negro slaves by the names of Sam, Sam Champion, Ambrose, Dick, Tom, Drury Debory & Dicks. I give to her and her heirs forever.

Item

Item	I give half of my Stock of all kinds to my stepson Grand son Thomas Debory Holloman to be equally divided and kept on the plantation for his use, I say to him and his heirs forever.
Item	I give half of my Stock of all kinds to my stepson Charlotte Holloman to be equally divided, and also one half of all my Household goods and furniture of whatever kind. I say to her and her heirs forever.
Item	I give to my stepson Grand son Thomas Debory Holloman all my Tools and Utensils of whatever kind to be kept on the plantation for the plantation use, also one half of all my Household goods and furniture of whatever kind after being equally divided between him and his Mother, I say to him and his heirs forever.
Item	I give to my Brother Solomon Debory all my wearing clothes of all sorts to him and his heirs forever.
Item	I give to my Brother Henry Debory fifty pounds Virginia currency to him and his heirs forever.
Item	I give unto my stepson Daughter Charlotte Holloman and her son Thomas Debory Holloman all the ready money I am possessed with to be equally divided betwixt each of them & their heirs forever after paying my just debts & legacies.
Item	I give to my stepson Daughter Charlotte Holloman and her son Thomas Debory Holloman all the remaining part of my estate which I have not already mentioned.

I do hereby nominate and appoint Casim Holloman and my Brother Henry Debory his and sole executors of this my last Will and Testament ratifying this and no other to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have this the 10<sup>th</sup> April 1794 signed sealed published and declared this to be my last Will & Testament
