In the Name of God Amen I John Evans of Northampton County North Carolina being of sound and Perfect Mind and Memory thanks be to God do this twenty fourth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and one make and Publish this to be my Last Will and Testament in Manner following -

First My Will and desire is that all my Just Debts be paid before to my dear Wife Evans five Pounds in Cash to be paid to her School her also her husband to purchase her a Pair of Spectacles such a one as my Executors may think proper, also one Chest and all my Clothing, and heres Books and Pen, one Iron Stove, one Pair Iron Stoves to her she have power

My Will and desire is that my Executors sell my Land whereon I live here, also all my Estate both Real & Personal to the Highest Bidder for Cash as they may think proper and after paying all my Just Debts & the Charges before said pay the Balance of the Money arising from the Sale to be Equally Divided among my four Children (James) Wally Evans, Marster Evans, Dolly Evans, John Evans & Bird Evans

My Will and desire is that if in case my dear Bird should die before he comes to lawful age or Marries that my Daughters Dolly Perry have half of all his Estate the other half to be Divided between Wally Marster and John Evans to them & their heirs forever Lastly I hereby make and assign my worthy Trustee James Mc Clark and my son in law John Perry Executors to this my Last Will & Testament. Peter Stewarts Will

In the Name of God Amen Peter Stewart of Northampton County and State of North Carolina being of sound Mind and Memory of Mine thanks be given unto God therefore knowing that it is appointed for all Mankind to Die do make this my Last Will and Testament in

Manner as follows following
 I have given unto my dear Wife below Wife all my share during her life have given my Horse Cattle Pigeon and Poultry and all my debts and bid me furniture all my Books and my Potts during her life and after her Death to be Equally divided among my Children

I have also given unto my Wife fifteen Dollars here and different Quantity of goods as she shall think sufficient for her use. I have also given unto my Children all the remainder of my Estate to be equally divided among them except my good Child Lewis Stewart which it is my desire shall have an equal share with the Children I have also given unto my dear Wife the following Plantation being the same as the Constitution of the same James Stewart my Executor to this my Last Will and Testament according to this my Will and Testament
