 a weak & Sickly State of Health But in perfect sound
 Mind and Memory calling to mind the uncertainty
 of human life do make and declare this to be my
 last Will and Testament in Manner as followeth (To wit)
 I give to my beloved Wife Nancy Merrymoons my Land
 and Plantations where I live for and during her
 Natural life a Widowhood, and after the Marriage
 of my Wife a her death before & after the death of the said
 Child to my Daughter Zephania Merrymoons that
 should my Wife at any time before the Marriage of
 my daughter Zephania do come to remove to the
 State of Ohio or any distant place, it is my Will and
 desire that my Executors (which shall be the said
 Child or she shall think it well convenient the best time
 and the Money arising therefrom to be appropriated
 to Purchasing more Land or any other State where
 my Wife may remove to, and the Land to Purchase
 from the Sale of Land which I now live on, or the Money
 arising therefrom after the Marriage or death of my
 Wife before & after the death of my Daughter Zephania
 Merrymoons to her then then given

It is my Will and desire that my Executors shall make
 Sale of as much of my Property as will discharge all
 my just debts, and after the payment of my debts
 before and hereafter unto my beloved Wife Nancy
 Merrymoons, all the rest and residue of my Estate

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 My last will and testament I do hereby make and declare

 I live during her Natural life or Widowhood, and the residue
 of my Estate to be paid and Equally divided between all my
 children to them then then given
 I appoint my Wife Julia Harts my Executor
 to this my last Will and Testament Witness my hand
 and seal this 7 day of February 1835
 I give and bequeath the said Land and Plantations to my
 Daughter Julia Harts and to her heirs forever
