I desire to make this my will and Testament in manner & form
following; and first of all I recommend my Body to the Lord from
whence it was taken, and my Soul to God that gave it, to be
disposed of according to his Will, and as it shall please God
to bestow some of his Wishes Good upon my I desire to dispose
of it in manner and form following; Viz: I am, first & in
that all my just Debts may be settled as I am first desirous
that the whole of my Lands five hundred & ninety nine Acres
be equally Divided between my Son Jesse Deloatch & William
Deloatch, and the whole of the remainder of my Estate I desire
it may be equally divided amongst the whole of my Children
Lawfully begotten of my Body, And I do nominate and approve

my Brother Francis Deloatch, and my Wife Sally Deloatch to be
