That I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth Mason my Negro man named George my Negro Woman named Sarah, with my stock of all kinds of Plantations utensils & House hold Furniture with my Cash & every thing that may be Signed my Estate to her the said George & Elizabeth

Lastly I appoint my Brother William Garrison whole Able Executor of this my last Will & Testament Discharging all that he, Executor shall have made by me of Money Money I have Received but may have I leave the way I hear some written

at their discretion and make use of it at their discretion also

I do ordain & appoint my Loving Wife Betty Jones my sole & lawful Executor to this my last Will & Testament

Revolving all other to be my Will but this this 10th day of October 1800
