

Arthur Hollimon's Will.

In the name of God Amen I Arthur Hollimon of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina am in a tottale Note of health at present and of sound mind and memory thanks to the god therfor and calling to mind that it is appinited for all men now to die do make testatute and confirme this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following first of all I give my Soul to Almighty God that you it and my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the direction of my Executors hereafter mentioned and as to my worldly goods that it hath pleased Almighty God to sett me with I gow and dispon of in the following manner to wit

I prins I send unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Hollimon all my Land lying on the upper side of the Spring Branch during her life or widowhood also and my beloved wife all my Slaves where we now live and the ground we have enclosed round the house for the purpor of a garden & also had my beloved wife all my Household Staff of all kinds Kitchen furniture to her during her widowhood or life also had my beloved wife Elizabeth there Negro known by the name of Charles Sneyer & Anna during her widowhood or life also had my wife one half of my Stock of all kinds during her widowhood or life I give unto my beloved wife thirty barrels of corn to begin with.

Item I give unto my Son Euan Hollimon all my Lands lying on the lower side of the Spring Branch to him and his heirs forever also give unto my Son Euan Hollimon all my Lands lying on the upper side of the Spring Branch at the expiration of the widowhood or life of my wife Elizabeth to him and his heirs forever also give unto my Son Euan Hollimon four Negroes by the names of Lewis Sneyer Sarah Gibby together with all their future increase to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Grand Son Sepe Dole One Negro boy by the name of Isham to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Dole One Negro girl by the name of Patience to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give unto my grand son Benjamin Dole One Negro girl by the name of Anna at the expiration of the widowhood or life of my wife Elizabeth with all her future increase to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Son Euan Hollimon ten Negroes by the name of Charles & Lucy at the expiration of the widowhood or life of my wife Elizabeth with all their future increase to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Son Euan Hollimon one half of my Stock of all kinds to him and his heirs forever I also give unto my Son Euan at the Stock that my wife Elizabeth may have at the expiration of her widowhood a lego to him and his heirs forever.

Item My desire is at the expiration of the widowhood or life of my beloved wife Elizabeth that all the Household Staff and Kitchen furniture be equally divided between my daughter in law Arthur Dole and my Grand Children Sally Miller, Willie Miller, Allen, and Euan Dole to them and their heirs forever In nomine and appinited my Son Euan Hollimon and my son in law Arthur Dole my sole and sole executors of this my last Will and Testatute In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 29th day of September 1794.
