 Son, William Summers & John Summers also to my Wife & also that  
 my Executors shall be made of my Stocks or other things, my Executors  
 I constituted & ordain official my truly friends Wm. Summers whole  
 & Sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament do hereby  
 & Resolving all other in this Will I have set my hand  
 & Seal this fifth day of October the Thirtieth eight hundred  
 & seven

I give & bequeath to Thomas Coxins son of my Brother Thomas  
 Coxins all the Land thought of William Hays lying in Franklin  
 County by him to be possessed & enjoyed forever

I give & bequeath to my sister Elizabeth Coxins all the property which  
 is now in her possession by her to be possessed & enjoyed forever

I give & bequeath to Jeremiah Battle all the property now in his hands  
 which I have a bill of sale by him to be possessed & enjoyed forever

I give & bequeath to my neighbour Daniel Copeland all the property  
 now in his hands after paying to my Executors his acct due me by him  
 to be possessed & enjoyed forever

I give & bequeath to Stephen Coffey the third part of all the property  
 arising from the Lands & Sales of Wm. Coffey in Northampton  
 & also I give & bequeath to Stephen Coffey the third part of a share  
 of money due me by Wm. Coffey from Wm. Coffey by him to be  
 possessed & enjoyed forever

Living but if she dies before she is married to  
then in that case I give it to Mr Horne son of the  
by him fully to be possessed & enjoyed forever

Item My desire is that my negro man Sam should be  
Plantation as long as he may live that my Executors pay him  
fifty dollars out of my Estate to his own disposing or he may

Item I give & bequeath to my beloved Wife Charity Horne an half  
of my Estate which is not yett given away after paying my debts  
her fully to be possessed & enjoyed for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my Cousin William Horne an half of all my  
Estate which is not given away both of my negroes & all other property by him  
fully to be possessed & enjoyed for ever

Item All the remainder of my whole <sup>estate</sup> which is not given away I give & bequeath  
to my Brother Joseph Horne & Sams Horne my Cousins to be divided  
to be equally divided amongst them each one shall take by them fully  
to be possessed and enjoyed forever

Further more I do hereby make & ordain my Brother Joseph Horne  
& Cousin William Horne of Bertie County my whole sole Executors of this my  
last Will & Testament in Writing whereof I the said <sup>said</sup> William Horne  
have set my hand & seal the day & Year above
