

George Jordan's Will

In the name of God AMEN George Jordan of Jordans Creek in the state of North Carolina being at present in good health of body and mind, and of my mind to be & I beseeche God heref ore and calling to mind the infirmities of my body, with grace and direction of my pastor and teacher in name and known following that is to say, I send unto Elizabeth Jordan the wife of my son Benjamin Jordan to her Negro man in his possession known by the name of Jeffreys Lewis and Sarah, during her widowhood or life.

Item I give and bequeath unto my grandson James Jordan the son of Benjamin Jordan and to his other names Negro Jeffreys after the above Elizabeth Jordan marriage or death to him and his heirs forever. Likewise unto my friend the Amazander or Negro known by the name of Luke which he now is Negro man of Jeffreys and his heirs forever - and my desire is that he also names Negro Lewis & Sarah after the above Elizabeth Jordan marriage or death should be equally divided among all the children of Benjamin Jordan the above mentioned to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Jordan four Negroes which he is now in possession of known by the name of Rebecca Shadrack, Ladd & Coates to him and his heirs forever, also I give unto my son Jacob Jordan four Negroes which I am now in possession of known by the name of Maria & Rose to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Hezekiah Jordan my plantation and all my lands and all my stock beside what I shall hereafter give away and my Negro known by the name of Littleton Johnson, Solomon, John, Jacob, Obie & Frank to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give unto my daughter Hannah Clinton twenty shillings, also land unto my daughter Hannah Clinton my negro woman known by the name of Anna and all her children which she the said negro woman shall have got and all her increase during her life and after her death my desire is that all the said Negroes should be equally divided among all my daughter Hannah Clinton children to them & their heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Oliver Jordan twenty shillings and also land unto my daughter Oliver Jordan four Negroes known by the names of Lucy, Ned, Fall and Melinda during her life and all her increase and my desire is that after my daughter Oliver Jordan's

Death that all the Negroes that I have left to her and their increase should be equally divided among all her children only her son George Jordan to have as part of said Negroes to him and their heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Grand son George Jordan the son of my daughter Oliver Jordan no Negro boy known by the name of Davis and is in the possession of Thomas Jordan to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Farver twenty shillings and also land unto my daughter Elizabeth Farver one Negro woman known by the name of Hannah which my daughter Elizabeth Farver is now in possession of, and all her children only one Negro boy known by the name of James which my said Daughter is now in possession of, and all her children their increase during her life and my desire is after my Daughter Elizabeth Farver's death that all the Negroes that I have left her and their increase should be equally divided among all my daughter Elizabeth Farver children to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Grand son Richard Farver the son of my daughter Elizabeth Farver one Negro by known by the name of Samy now in the hands of my Daughter Elizabeth Farver to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Maryfield Jordan twenty shillings and also land unto my daughter Maryfield Jordan one Negro woman known by the name of Middle and her child known by the name of Charles and their increase during her life, and my desire is that after my daughter Maryfield Jordan's death that the Negroes that I have left to her should be equally divided among all the children of my Daughter Maryfield Jordan to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give unto my daughter Sally Jordan, one bed furniture, ten acres and labor my side saddle, ten Negroes known by the name of Lucy & Hannah to her and her heirs forever.

Item I leave unto my beloved wife Hannah Jordan six Negroes known by the names of Old Harry, George, Dick, Ned, Samy, Old Lucy, and Horse, five cows and calves, one bed and furniture, one pot, one pan, two dishes, ten plates, six glasses, six spoons, and fork and knife sufficient for one year provision during her life.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Joseph Parker all the remainder of my estate that I have not given away, and all that now left to my beloved wife at her death to her and his heirs forever.

And I do constitute and appoint my beloved Son Joseph Parker to be my Grand Lawyer, Smith, my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament, dismouthing and making void all other wills by me hitherto made. At witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 22^d day of December 1799.

Joseph Parker's Will

To all to whom these presents shall be made known a Declaration
know ye that Joseph Parker of Southampton County in the State of
North Carolina, being weak of body but of perfect memory and sound judgment
do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form
as follows:

First It is my Will and desire that all my just debts and funeral expences be
discharged by my Executor hereafter named.

Secondly I give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife Sarah Parker one feather bed
and furniture, my riding Horse, and side saddle, and her post and flying
piano, two parlor Chairs, two poster Boxes, Four plates one Chest made
her, and two chins to her and at her disposal forever.

Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my son Jeremiah Parker my plantation
and lands and all the rest belonging thereto a plantation Grappler the
John Murray formerly had, which I bought of Nathan Miller and
said Murray, after the Death was taken of said Grappler and

one small gun; and the other unbroken Tools that formerly belonged to said Parker
to him and his Heirs forever.

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my son Sarah Parker the plantation wherein I
am now and all the Land bought of Thomas Hayes and of John and
Matthew Griffin, containing six hundred and forty five acres and a half
and one half of my Grand's Sett, half of my Wife's saw one Gun that I
bought of Timothy Hall, and all my Colors used to him and his Heirs
forever upon his express trust that he the said Sarah Parker will
take due care of and find a sufficient maintenance for her Mother my
dear deceased wife suitable to her degree, and also find her convenient House
room during her natural life or until Marriage, also that the said
Sarah Parker do at my half of the expense of finding timber for a
Garrison House twenty feet by sixteen and also one half the Bricks
for a Chimney to said House it being for my use. Remained long after
named.

Fifthly I give and bequeath unto my Son Alexander Parker above named
his bought of John King and John Common and side Martin the
bought of John Parker, and one Horse called "Sorrel" one riding
saddle two guns that I bought of Nathan Rodgers, Two Boxes
and also one feather bed and furniture two Boxes two Pewter &
Piggy Weight Plates, one Pewter Dish six Pewter Plates, and all my
Crockery sets, and the remainder of my Pewter dishes Tools, and my
Clock, and few pounds due me from John Benjamin Patterson, and
the other half of my aforesaid Grappler Hill & Mill saw to him and
his Heirs forever.

Sixthly I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Judith Parker one feather bed &
junction box four Chairs two Boxes and Lands and Fifty thousand dollars
Dollars or as much current money as shall be sufficient to exchange for
a purchase the above sum of hard Dollars at the time of payment
one Bushel, one Child and one Friend to her and his Heirs forever.

Seventhly I give all the remaining part of my estate of every kind to be equally
divided between my wife Sarah Parker and my four Children
namely Jeremiah, Sarah Alexander and Judith Parker to them &
their heirs forever.

Eightly
