Item I give to my Daughter Martha Broom five Shillings

Agree to my Daughter Winifred. There are three women. One is a negro girl
 Hannah, one Negro girl Fanny, one Negro boy that one Negro boy sister
 Mary & three African school boys.

Then I write to my grand Daughter Rebecca by an express woman. I am express
 Dry Lane an express first messenger an express boy Luke they three show me to be
 entering on the natural life. I have heard how Paul sangfully forgotten after long. This I
 give the express to them. Their Pass for Conjugal have now this sangfully beginning
 how long then I give the word Express Star, Lane, Messon & Luke they three show me
 to be a greatly Lucius between my two Sons Richard by an express boy. Then
 I show to them their Pass for ever.

Am. Increase to them & their heirs forever
I give my son John Rogers the plantation whereon he dwells and all that lye over the
West side of the Mill pond also the mill & pond as you will & water. Excess wages
The Crispin Branch is a wooded tract along a line of a pond at the West. Hence along

Negro girl Call they & their Increase to him. One Horse seven I also give to him all my
Stock that is not mentioned.

The balance of my Estate not given away in my last Will my Executors should sell the money arising from such Sale after deducting Last Debts and have to be equally divided between my three youngest Children namely Francis Dols, Benjamin Dols, & Cherry Dols to them & their heirs forever also my Desire is that the Property last my self after my Death be equally divided between my three youngest Children Francis, Benjamin, & Cherry. Except that I desire that my grandson, Brother Dols should have the care & half of his brother Cherry Dols share with him in decisions amongst their youngest as within mentioned And I desire make & bequeath my Son Francis Dols Benjamin Dols Executors of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have signed these my last Will & Testament set my Hand &c.
