whereas I now live during her Life or Widowhood also one
Furniture and furniture two sheets one Blanket one smock
Kane four hags I have built the house I have happy
also one half my plantation I sold two Iron pots Tying
Pots also my Carthen and pewter ware except six pewter plates
and one pewter dish also two Tubs also all my sitting chair
also two pious Books and books and all my slays Skirts
and Kinnis spots and one side saddle & Bridle

I have suggested to my son Henry that he and Father
 be well furnished and well clothed first, then I also give to
 my son Henry that he thirty acres of Virginia money
 to have his horse and signs furnished.

Now I am that all the rest of my property, Land, Negroes and
any thing else that I possess I give to my son Andrew his
and Mary's Heirs to be equally divided by Robert Fox
Henry Menden and James Cook or the Survivors of them

My Will is that my Estate shall be appraised & likewise
constituted under and underlain Robert Fox and my
Treasurer

For Henry Foster See my whole and sole Executors of this my
Last Will and Testament and I do hereby entirely disallow them
and disannul all and every other former Will Testament Leg
and bequests and Executors by and as any and before named
Wills and bequests Relating and confirming this and
as others to be my Last Will and Testament to Whom I hereby
Shew hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this 5th day
of October 1801
