In the name of God Amen I Thomas Vaughan of the County of Northampton and the Province of North Carolina being at present very feeble in body but of sound mind and memory thanks be to God in the same calling to mind the mortality of my body do make and revive this my last Will and Testament that is to say I give and bequeath that all my actual debts be paid and discharged

Item I give and bequeath to my wife Martha Vaughan One Horse saddle and also two new Chaises

Item I give and bequeath to my Son John One Gun

And the rest of my property to be equally divided among my Wife and Children I do constitute and name William Tuttle Esq. Clerk of the Court my whole and sole executor of this my last Will and Testament revoking and making void all other wills hers before made by me I do hereby declare that I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 25th day of August An. Dom. 1796 —

Benjamin Liles's Will

In the name of God Amen I Benjamin Liles of Northampton County in the State of North Carolina being in perfect mind and memory do make and revive this my last will and Testament that is to say I give and bequeath unto my wife Mary Liles all my Lands during her life.

Item I likewise I give unto my wife Mary Liles the rest of my estate during her life to raise my children except my Daughters should marry in which I give and bequeath to each of them One new and yearling likewise One feather bed & Furniture to them and their heirs forever. And after my wife deceases I desire that my Lands may be sold and equally divided among my Sons which I give to them and their heirs forever, likewise that at the rest of my estate shall be sold and after my just debts being paid that it may be equally divided among all my Children which I give to them and their heirs forever I do nominate and ordain Benjamin Blisset and my Brother Sigmund Liles my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby disannul & revoke all other wills and Testaments previous to this but do ratify and confirm this to be my last will and Testament I do hereby declare that I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 12th day of July 1791
