name of Remond & her Children future increase during her natural life and after her  
death to be equally divided among all her Children, Those & I share alike to them all  
those and upsons former.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Pitts Jordan the Negroe who has already received  
as per will of late deceased Court

I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Polly Bridges the following Negroe to wit) Lucy  
Polly and just and all their increase to her & her Heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Penelope or my girl by the name of Nancy to her & her Heirs forever  
I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Ruthy Pitts or Pitts to her & her Heirs forever

James, Alfred, & Jonathan Moore. I shall myself publish back to said Children after a funeral to them to their several properties forever.

I hereby revoke all former Wills & Testaments this day my last Will and Testament, and now make & publish my living wife Rebecca Moore Executrix to my Brother James Moore, Eliz. Lucy Hayes, James Morris to my friend & take his executors Executors to this my last will & Testament. In witness whereof these documents my hand affixed my Seal this 28th day of October 1800.
