I give also to my two sons Benjamin Collier & Joshua Collier one feather Bed of Furniture each like I have to my son Benjamin Collier one horse & colt

Item I give to my two Daughters Sally Collier & Mary Collier one feather Bed of Furniture each

Item I give to my daughter in Law Sarah Collier one feather Bed of Furniture

Item My Will is that the execution of the Deeds that my Negroes together with all my other personal property of every description be equally divided between my four Children namely Benjamin Collier Joshua Collier Sally Collier & Mary Collier except the property I had to my Wife which I will to be divided between all my Children after the death of my Wife to them their heirs & assigns forever

My Will & desire is that my Slave should not be appraised

I do hereby make in and give my beloved Wife Sally Collier & my three Children Robert my Wife the Executor of this my last Will & Testament & I do hereby utterly disinherit Thomas & Susan and all of every other Person living or hereafter to be born in any line of mine named or to be hereafter named & bequeathing & bequeathing that the same to be my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & first day of March this 30th day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & seven

Mark Murrills Will

In the Name of God Amen I Mark Murrill of the County of Northampton & State of North Carolina being weak of body but of sound perfect mind & memory do make & publish this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following (that is to say)

First I give & bequeath unto my Wife Sarahanna Murrill one negro boy Isaac also one Negro Girl Fanny

Secondly After the payment of my just debts I give & bequeath unto my nephew John Murrill all the rest of my estate both real & personal to him his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby appoint & do execute of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all other Wills by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this first day of March in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & seven

Signe & seals published & declared by the above named Mark Murrill in the presence of us who at his request in his presence have hereunto subscribed our names as Witnesses to the same
