And my Will and desire is that the rest of my estate should be sold and after my just debts is paid to be equally divided between my Son Lemuel Marr and my Daughter Mitty Marr.

And I do hereby nominate and appoint my Son Lemuel Marr, Isaac Parker and William Glanvaux my whole and sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke, and disannul all and every other former Testaments, Wills, devises, Legacies and bequests ratifying and confirming this to be my last Will and Testament IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my hand and fixed my Seal this 10th day of May anno

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Marmaduke Norfleet's Will

In the name of God Amen I Marmaduke Norfleet of the province of North Carolina and County of Northampton being upwards of seventy four years of age and being in perfect sound mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of all mankind, as willing to settle all my temporal affairs my senior journey is to Almighty God to review my Soul after death and that my body may be buried in a decent Christian like manner at the discretion of my executors whom I shall hereafter appoint my just debts being first paid. Having satisfied, I do dispose of the remainder of my estate in form and manner as follow.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Ruben Norfleet several parcels of land and timber lying on the North side of Roanoke river and joining each other and lying in both Northampton County & Roanoke County being the lands which I bought of James Gilmer Benjamin Faxon & Ruben Norfleet & Richard & John Whitaker likewise the lands on the South side of Roanoke river that I have already made over to my son Ruben Norfleet by a Deed of Gift I do acknowledge it to be a free gift all the above mentioned Lands I give to my Son Ruben Norfleet and his Heirs forever, Likewise give to my Son Ruben Norfleet a parcel of Negroes that he has had in possession for some time past that is to say one Negroe man called Harry one Negroe man called Daniel, one Negroe man called Abram one Negroe woman called Haga, and all her children excepting one Negroe girl called Anna, Likewise I give him one Negroe woman called Rose and all her children, Likewise I give him one Negroe man called Tony, Likewise I give him one Negroe woman called old Nancy Likewise give to my Son Ruben Norfleet all my Stock of cattle and Hogs that is under the care of Miles Young and the work house & pleugh belonging to that plantation where Miles Young lives and a young slave called Dennis.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Judith Baker the Land and plantation wherein Joshua Fletcher now lies on the east side of the Liffey Creek being the Land that I bought of William Brundish lying and being in Bedford County, I say I give it to her and her heirs, but if she should die without an Heir begotten of her body my will is that it should fall to my Son

Item Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Judith Parker all my Stock of Cattle and Horses and work horses and ploughs and a young Cow all belonging to the above mentioned plantation.

Item Give and bequeath to my Daughter Judith Parker several negroes that she has now in her possession namely one negro woman called Lucy and the children that she hath with her which are called by name Ruth, Ben, Nancy & Clarissa, likewise give to my Daughter Judith three negro men called Henry, Jack, and Dial that she has now in her possession and likewise give to my Daughter Judith two negro men called Tom and Dempsey which she has not yet had in her possession. —

Item Give and bequeath to my Daughter Judith her feather beds and the furniture belonging to them. —

Item Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Jeffreys the land and plantation whereon I now live which I bought of — lying in Northampton County with the land and plantation whereon Amos Parker now lives say Give it to my Daughter Sarah Jeffreys and to her heirs begotten of her body, and if she should die without an heir begotten of her body my will is that it should fall to my Son Reuben and his Heirs, likewise give to my Daughter Sarah all my Stock of Horses & Cattle with the work horses ploughs & harrows belonging to the same plantation and one young riding Horse called Bolly.

Item Give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Dorothy Rogers namely one negro man called old Jack, one mulatto man called Dick one negro man called Jimmy one negro man called Carter and said Carter Julius Crater, one work called Morris one work called Sall one girl called Felicia say Give the above named negroes to my Daughter Sarah then and there increased during her life and after her death to be equally divided amongst her children but if she should die without I say the above named negroes Give to be equally divided amongst my Son Reubens Children. —

Item Give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Jeffreys all my Household furniture except four feather beds and the furniture thereunto belonging. —

Give and bequeath unto James Snofflet the son of Philibet Snofflet Grandson to my Brother James Snofflet the land and plantation whereon Henry Spikes now lives lying in Northampton County on the east side of an branch of the head of Currituck swamp being the land that I bought of William Robertson Likewise give unto the above named James Snofflet all the Stock of Cattle belonging to the above said plantation.

Item Give and bequeath to the above said James Snofflet two young Negroes namely Derry & Celia my will is that if the above named James Snofflet should die without issue or before he arrives to the age of nearly one year then the above Land, Horses & Stock to be sold to the best bidder & the money arising from the sale of the said Negroes & Stock to be equally divided amongst my three Children namely Rubia Snofflet, Judith, and Sarah, or to their Heirs.

Item Give and bequeath unto Edmund Stone the Land plantation whereon Ephraim Adams now lies with the Stock of Cattle belonging to the same plantation say Give the aforesaid Land and Stock of Cattle to him and his Heirs if in case no such person can be found then my will is that his sister Susannah or her heirs should inherit the Land and Stock of Cattle and if in case there is no such person as Susannah Stone or her Heirs or her heirs to be found then the above mentioned Land and plantation and Stock of Cattle shall be sold to the highest bidder and the money arising from the sale of the said Land and Stock of Cattle to be equally divided amongst my three Children namely Rubia, Judith & Sarah.

Item My will is that Thomas Brown should have the use of the Land and plantation and Stock of Cattle as he has had therfore during his life that is to say to raise cattle for the one fourth part long will is that after his long death the Land plantation and my part of the Stock of Cattle shall be sold to the highest bidder and the money arising from the sale of the said Land and Stock of Cattle to be equally divided amongst

amongst my three children namely Reuter, Judith & Sarah
the begin that I let my Son Remadake Norfleet have the use of
in his life time my wife is that as her Daughter Mrs. Babb
has the one half of the aforesaid virgin, that her Daughter Anna
Norfleet should have the other half when she arrives to the age
of eighteen years or marries her.

This I make as my last Will and Testament making void all
other wills made before by writing and I do hereby ordain & appoint
my brother and wife beloved Son Reuter Norfleet
and my very good friend William Baker and my approved
friend James Hogan to be my true and lawful Execu-
tors to see this my last Will and Testament exhibited and
published according to the true intent and meaning of the
above written Will and Testament signed sealed and
acknowledged the twenty eighth day of June in the year
four Thousand One thousand seven hundred and Twenty
four.
