

Jacob Adams Will

In the Name of God amen I Jacob Adams of Northampton County & State of North Carolina being Weak in Body but of sound & Perfect Mind & Memory bless be almighty God for the same, do make & publish this my last Will & Testament in Manner & form following, that is to say First In the first Place It is my Will that all my last debt should be paid as speedily as possible

Second, I Give to my Beloved Wife Angelina Adams and Mine of the Plantation wherew I now reside during her natural life together a month of all my other Property which I give to her & her heirs forever say the Ninth

Third I Give to Charles Adams my eldest Son, and his & his heirs forever my Name & Mills to him & his heirs forever

Fourth I Give to my Son Moses Adams I give my old Plantation wherew he now lives to him & his heirs forever

Fifth I Give to my Son William Adams I give the third Part of the Land I now live upon & the Part wherew he has made a settlement to him & his heirs forever

Sixth I Give to my Son Richmond Adams I give one third Part of the Plantation wherew I now live where he is to stay to him & his heirs forever

Seventh I Give to my Son Randolph Adams I give one third Part of the Plantation wherew I now live where he may go to him & his heirs forever

Eighth I Give to my Daughter Mary Frazier five shillings & the whole of what may remain of my Property to be sold and equally divided between Charles Adams, William Adams, Richmond Adams, Randolph,

Randolph Adams, Rachel Davis my daughter Charles Adams & Mary Adams to them & their heirs forever

Ninthly

I Appoint my Son William Adams Charles Adams to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament fully executing all former Wills by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 15 day of July in the year of our L^d 1803

I Give Charles Adams & William Adams by the above named Executors to be his last Will & Testament, in the presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names as Witnesses in presence of the Judge
