and having that it is sufficient for all uses to do what  
is done this to be my last Will and Testament (vis)

Now I give and command my soul in the hand of Almighty God  
that you are relying on the Trinity for beneficent favors -  
for salvation nothing doubting but I have had a glorious  
meeting with the Saints at the Morning of the resurrection  
and my Body to be buried in a decent Christian like  
manner at the expense of my Estate Landed and  
and a sum of money which I left plus  
God to help me with. You divide and dispose of the same in  
whatever and from following (vis).

Now I give and bequeath unto the sum of my dear Husband  
Fardin and forty shillings to him and his heirs for  
ever as their whole part of my Estate.

Now I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Lucy Parsons  
all the remainder of my Estate not already given  
away both in lands personal and chattels and such does  
wholly and fully to her and her heirs forever -

Now I nominate and appoint my beloved wife Lucy Parsons my  
wife and sole Executrix to this my last Will and Testament  
in testimony whereof I have signed the same this 20th day of January  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine.
