In the Name of God Amen, I Lazarus Revell of the State of North Carolina County of Northampton being weak in body but of sound mind & memory do hereby certify that on the 10th day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty one, make public this my last Will & Testament in manner following that is to say:

First

I give & devise unto my loving wife Anne Revell my son Abigail's Wife my Daughter Polly Revell my son William & Mary all my Land & plantation whereof I now live, to be divided among them share & share alike, it them & their heirs forever,

Second

I devise unto my loving wife Anne Revell my service Horse until such my son Abigail's Revell comes to lawful age, at which time I give & devise unto my said son Abigail's Revell my said service Horse my new saddle & bridle to him this being forever

Third

I give unto my wife Anne Revell all my stock of cattle & Hogs my service mare & all the money I now have in hand together with all my personal estate that I now possess together with to her & her heirs forever, and I hereby make & be done my loving wife Anne Revell Executor of this my last Will & Testament, I hereby certify that the said Lazarus Revell has to this my last Will & Testament set my hand & seal the day & year above written, & published before us signed

I also appoint my son William Thompson my only Executor to this my last Will & Testament in witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this 10th day of May 1831
