and assigns forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Nathaniel Burger  
six hundred acres of land in Cumberland in the state  
of Georgia which I give my executor lawful power  
to sell or with the said land for the said land, provided  
they think proper and if the executor should sell  
the said land for them to purchase other land if  
they should have a convenient opportunity with the  
money they receive for the other said land to him  
his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I Give I give unto my son Nathaniel Burger a new & two  
knives which has been called his also two bed furniture  
to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son John Burger a belt  
named Dolphin also two Cow & two knives & handlings, also  
two bed furniture to him his heirs and assigns forever  
and for none of the property to be sold.

Item I Give unto my dearest beloved wife the use of all the remainder  
of my property during her natural life and hereafter give  
and at her decease for my son John to have the Buffet  
that now stands in the house and Chest called ~~my~~ and  
beds Cash, and unto my son Nathaniel Burger at my  
wife's decease to have two bed furniture also two Cow  
& knife yearling, and at my wife's decease I give all the  
remainder of my property unto my daughter Mary Burger  
to her heirs and assigns forever. — And

And I further nominate and appoint my dearest beloved friends  
Jehiel Cutland and William Cutland as Executors Executors  
as Executor to this my last Will and Testament whereunto I have  
set my hand and seal this the 23rd day of November in the

### Sampson Revill's Will

In the name of God Amen I Sampson Revill of Northampton  
County in the State of North Carolina being at present in perfect  
health of body and of good and sound memory thanks be to God  
and calling to mind the mortality of my body do give and  
bequeath my goods and Chattels in manner here following to wit  
First My will and desire is that all my just debts should be  
paid out of my estate.

Second. I Give unto my loving wife Margaret Revill during her  
natural life the land and plantation whereon I now live also  
all my household and kitchen furniture likewise all my  
stock of Cattle Hogs, Horses, and Sheep after the death  
of my loving wife I give unto my son Sampson Revill  
the land & plantation whereon I now live that is to say  
two hundred acres, second I give unto my son Matthew  
Revill the land and plantation whereon he now lives  
that is to say two hundred acres, if there is more land  
then each part in Land I desire that the balance may  
be divided between my two sons Matthew & Sampson.

Third I Give unto my son Matthew all my household  
furniture also I give to my two sons my hand mill and  
crop cut saw to Matthew & Sampson —

Jacob Jacobs Will

I Jacob Jacobs of Northampton County in the State of North Carolina being sick  
 and weak of Body and of sound mind and memory and calling to mind that  
 it is appointed for me to die do hereby make, declare this my last Will and  
 Testament as the manner and form as follows to wit

- Item I give to my wife Susannah Jacobs during life a widowhood all my  
 land with the use thereof but in case of remarriage only one third part
- Item I give to my two Sons Isaac and Joseph Jacobs the whole of my land  
 to be equally divided to each his part at the death of my wife  
 but if my Son or either of them should die under age for their part  
 a part for my son John Jacobs
- Item I give to my wife Susannah Jacobs all my Book and all Household  
 Furniture and plantation Utensils during her widowhood but in  
 case she marries to have one childs part
- Item I give to my Son Samuel one Dollar or the value thereof
- Item I give to my Son James Jacobs one Dollar or the value thereof
- Item I give to my Son Jacob Jacobs one Dollar or the value thereof
- Item I give to my Son William Jacobs one Dollar or the value thereof
- Item I give to my Daughters Mary & Elizabeth and Margaret and  
 Sarah and Rebecca Jacobs one Dollar for each or the value thereof
- Item I give to my three Children viz. Minerva and Rebecca and  
 John Jacobs the remainder of my personal estate to be equally  
 divided to each their parts at the marriage or decease of my wife  
 I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife Susannah Jacobs  
 to be my Executor and Richard Jordan and John Outland  
 to be my Executors in this my last Will and Testament whereunto  
 I have set my Hand and Seal As Witness hereof this 25<sup>th</sup>
